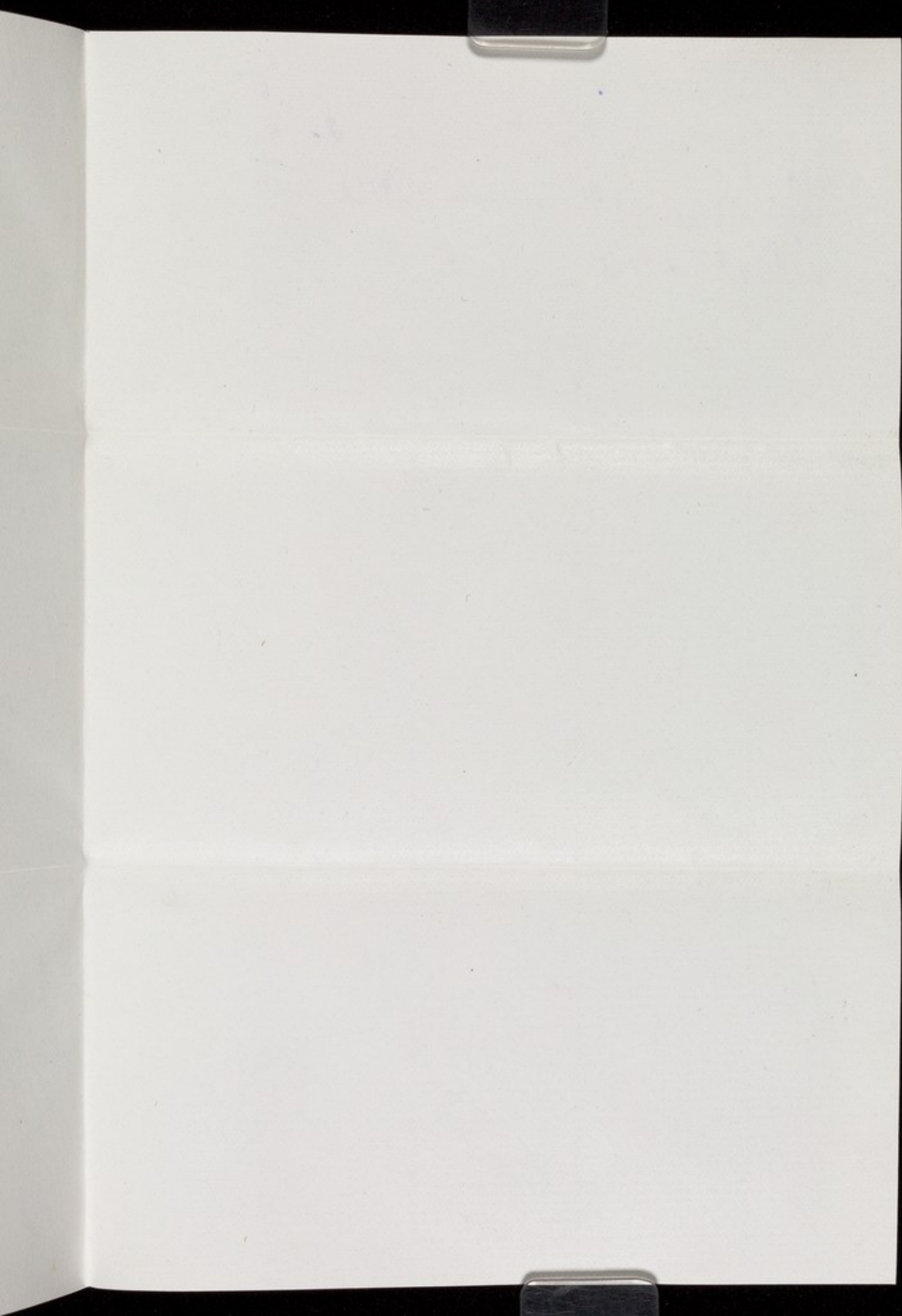

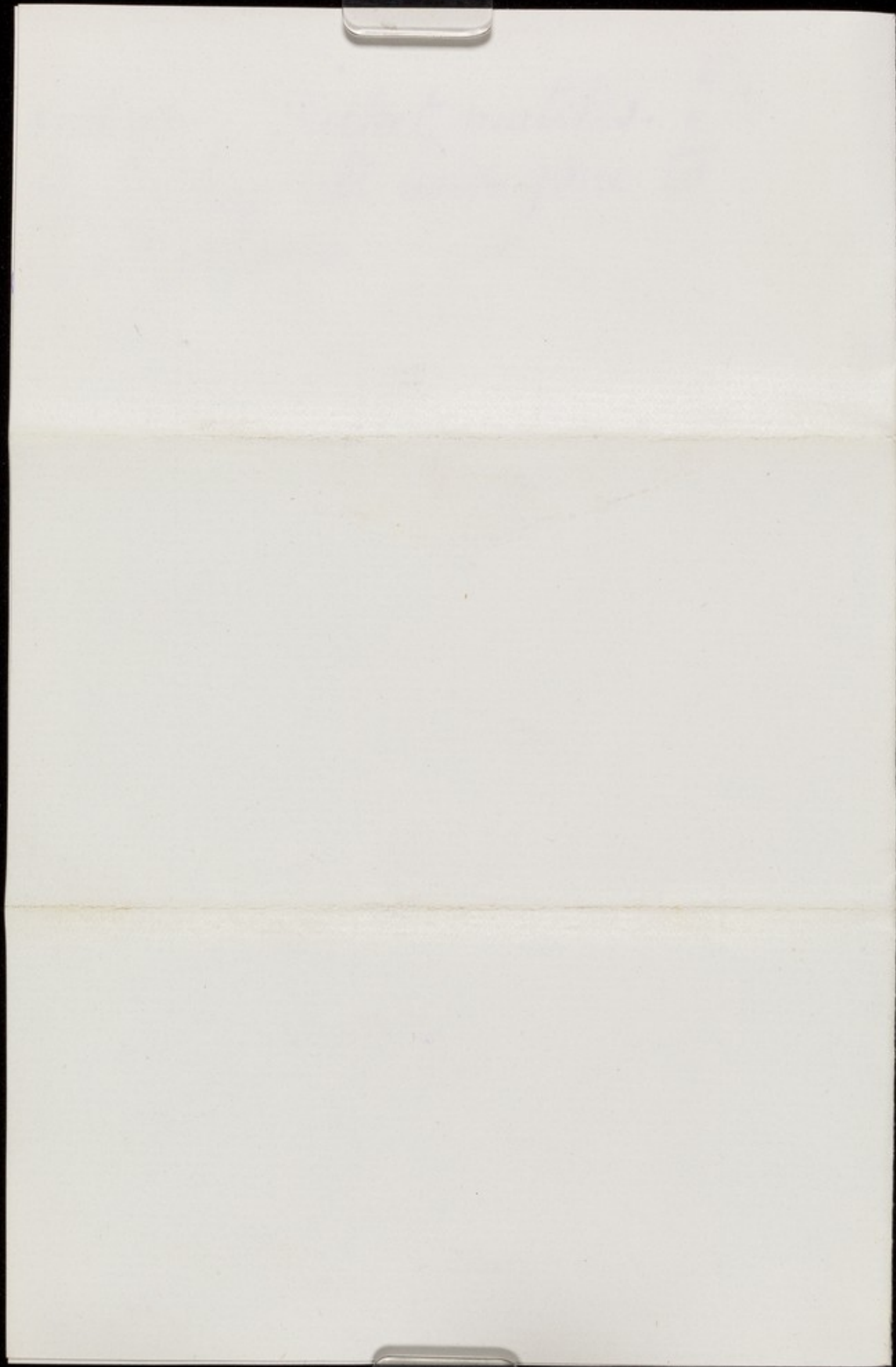
Friends
