In the Matter of ELIZA JANE COPE
Spinster a Person of Unsound Mind.

UPON READING THE CERTIFICATE of William Norris
Nicholson Esquire one of the Masters in Lunacy made in the above-
mentioned matter on the 24th day of July 1884—

I DO ORDER as follows :—

1. That the custody of the person and the regulation and govern-
ment of the above-named lunatic be committed and granted to her
first cousin once removed Anne Elizabeth Linwood late of Pockling-
ton in the county of York but now of Carlton near Worksop in the
county of Nottingham spinster.

2. That the custody regulation occupation disposition and receipt
of the estate of the said lunatic be committed and granted to
Benjamin Collett Pullan of Leeds in the county of York solicitor
such grant to take effect upon the certificate of the Masters in
Lunacy that he has completed his security as such committee.

3. That the whole net income of the said lunatic not exceeding
the sum of Two hundred and twenty pounds per annum be allowed
for her maintenance from the 30th day of June 1884.

4. That the several debts of the said lunatic mentioned in
paragraph 8 of the said Master's said certificate and the schedule
thereto be paid by the said Benjamin Collett Pullan as such
committee of her estate as aforesaid.

5. That the several shares and the household furniture and
effects of the said lunatic mentioned or referred to in paragraph 9 of
the said Master's said certificate be forthwith sold by the said
Benjamin Collett Pullan as such committee as aforesaid under the
direction of the said Masters in Lunacy.

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6. That for the purpose of completing the sale of the said shares of the said lunatic the said Benjamin Collett Pullan do as such committee of the estate as aforesaid of the said lunatic execute in her name and on her behalf such transfer or transfers of such shares to the purchaser or purchasers thereof as may be necessary and proper.

7. That the funds in Court of the said lunatic to the credit of this matter namely the matter of "Eliza Jane Cope spinster a person of unsound mind" as well as the funds to be lodged in Court to the same credit as by the Lodgment Schedule hereto directed be respectively dealt with as by such Lodgment and the Payment Schedule also hereto respectively directed.

8. That the reasonable and proper costs charges and expenses of the said Anne Elizabeth Linwood and Benjamin Collett Pullan as the Petitioners named in the said certificate of obtaining and prosecuting the order for inquiry in this matter and also their like reasonable and proper costs charges and expenses of incident to and consequent upon these proceedings be taxed and that the several amounts thereof when taxed and certified be paid by the said Benjamin Collett Pullan out of any moneys coming to his hands as such committee as aforesaid available for that purpose.

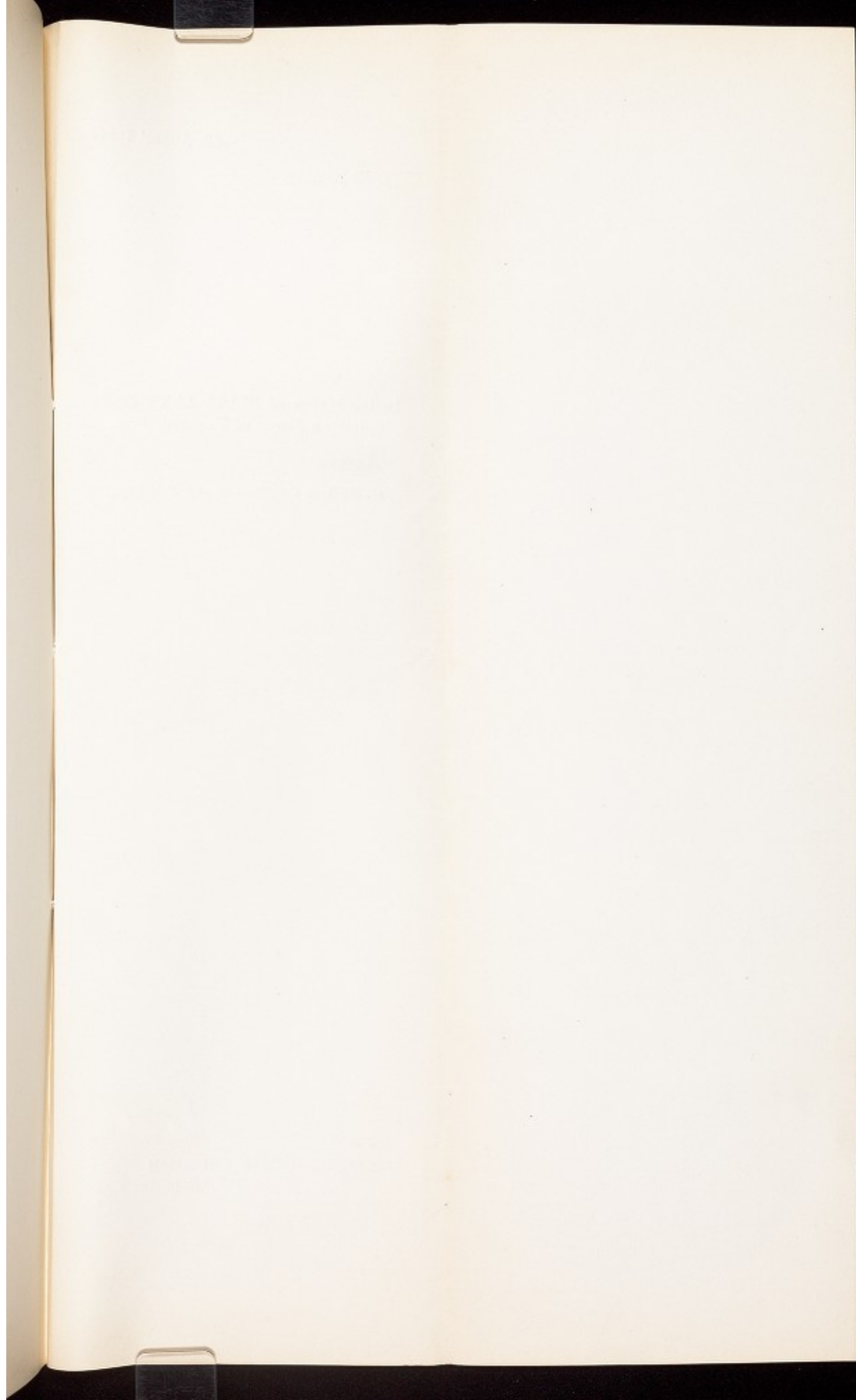
