I am mentally defreque the sie the entreme at times and this deposes me of for power and self reliance. thel I want to do without any 1 humanis; I need no coa. live oil nor been and tout the attendants will bruf no more. The wine which I arack I refund until it was for ud whow me . I did not ask first. I med no bunchen but that was forced whom me, and now it has become a practice with me to take it.

I have owne what I could me to save trouble to the apristances 16 here, and have aune what I rest could to help some of them, W. but they decline my apristance. avre What can I do to help de fire par the establishment here whose nes members have done so much 1 for me in finding food + sheller ' do please help me.
