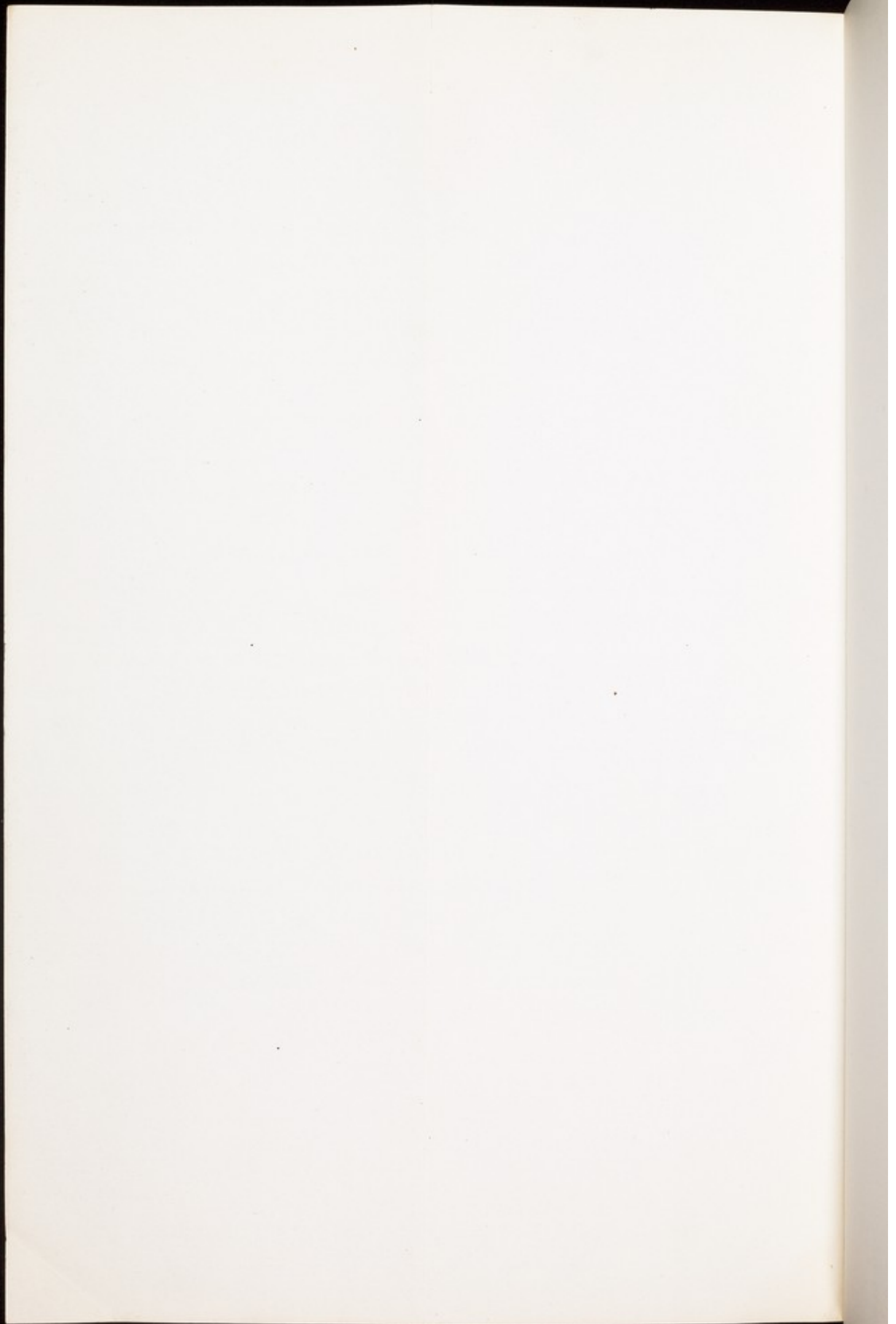
Take Notice that under the provisions of
the above mentioned Act Louis Auguste Le Gocq of 16
Rue d'Alton Ixelles les Bruxelles in the Kingdom of
Belgium Notary the Executor of the Will of the late
Richard George Clarke deceased under the circumstances
set forth in the Affidavit of the said Louis Auguste Le
Gocq filed in the above matters on the 13th day of April
1883 and with the privity of the Paymaster General on
the eighteenth day of April 1883 paid into the Bank of
England the sum of £78. 2. 11 to the credit of "In
the Matter of the Trusts of 1/5th part of a moiety of
a sum of £1000 bequeathed by the Will of the late
Richard George Clarke deceased" in accordance with the
provisions of the above mentioned Act of Parliament.

And also take Notice that you are named in the
said Affidavit as the person entitled to or interested in
the said fund
