THE LORD JUSTICE *Isaac Vaughan Williams* made on
the *7th* day of *November* 1899
to enquire concerning the alleged Lunacy of

before the said Commissioners or one of them on *Friday*
the *eight* day of *December* 1899 at

knowledge touching the alleged Lunacy of the said *Bristol Edward*
Swarris and of all such matters as shall be
demanded of you by virtue of the said Commission and Order Hereof fail
not at your peril.

I Brereton Edward Dwarries,
Clerk in Holy Orders, Master of Arts,
Incumbent or Vicar of the parish church
of St. Peter, Bywell in the County of
Northumberland in the Diocese of
Newcastle for certain just and lawful
causes me herunto especially moving
without compulsion fraud or deceit
Do purely simply and absolutely
resign and give up my said Office
of Incumbent or Vicar with all the
rights members and appurtenances
unto the hands of the Right
Reverend Father in God Edgar by
Divine permission Lord Bishop of
Newcastle or of any other whomsoever
that hath or shall have power to
admit this my resignation And
I totally renounce my right and
title to and possession of the
same with all the rights members
and appurtenances heretofore had
and hitherto belonging to me I quit
them and expressly recede from
them by these presents And that
this my resignation may have
its full effect I pray that the
said Right Reverend Father in God
will graciously vouchsafe to accept
this my resignation And to pronounce

decree and declare the Office of
Incumbent or Vicar aforesaid void and
to be void of my person to all intents
of law that may follow thereon and to
decree that intimation of the said
avoidance may be issued to the
parish thereof.
