but I am, however to

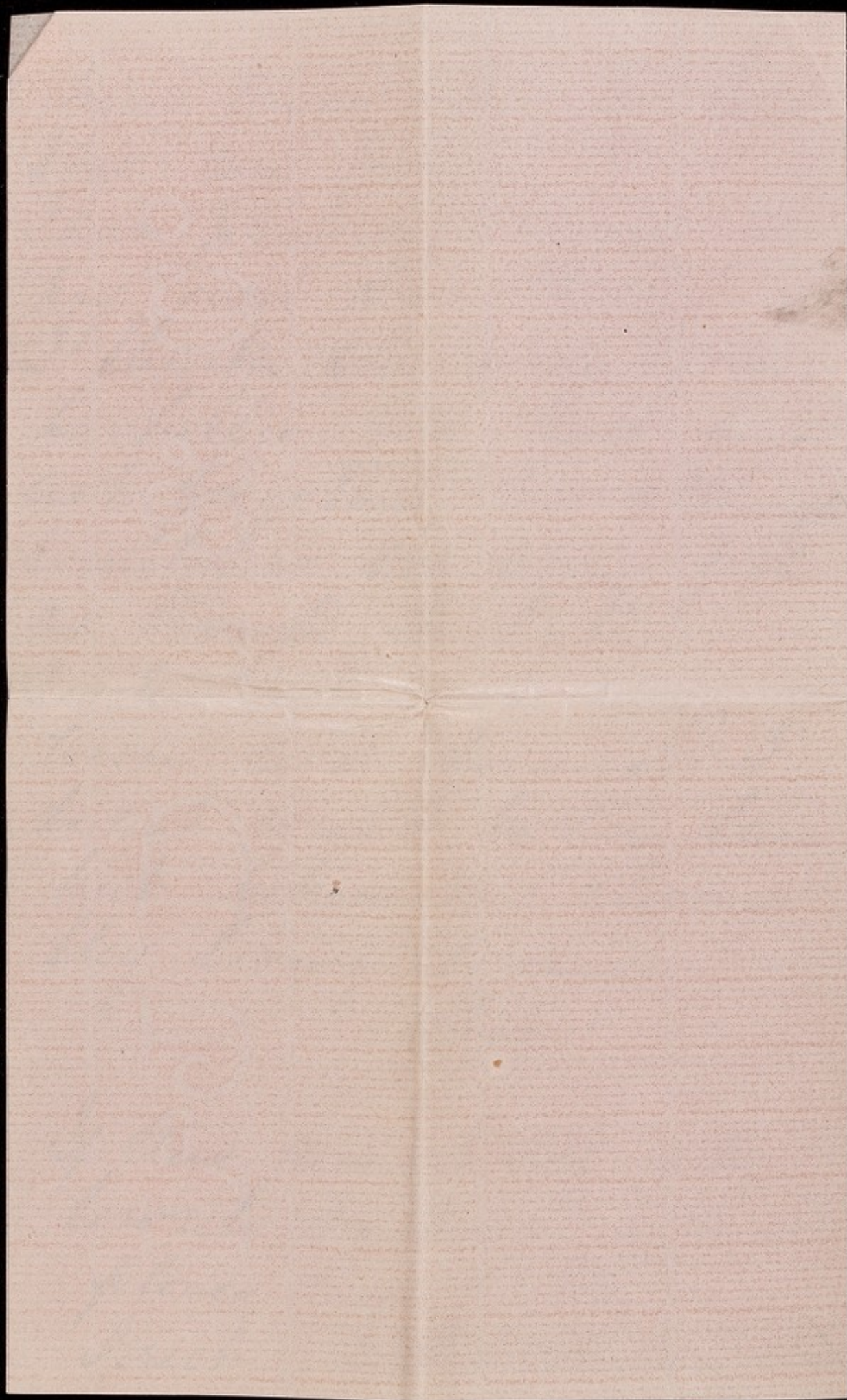
hear from myself how
