MISSING AT BIARRITZ.

Mr. Barnard, K.C. (with him Mr. Blakelock), made an application for leave to presume the death of Mr. Adolph Reiche. Counsel said he appeared on behalf of the son. Mr. Adolph Reiche formerly lived at Bradford, and was a wool and oil merchant. fortunately a few years ago his wife became insane, and in April, 1907, the deceased gentleman went to Biarritz for the benefit of his health. On the 10th of that month, after dinner, Mr. Reiche went for a walk along the diffs and he had not returned since. The following morning his hat, eye-glasses, matches, and a box of pills he was in the habit of using were discovered on the cliffs. His room at the hotel, which had been immediately locked, was found to contain £200 in notes and money. His life was not insured, but he left estate valued at £32,000. Advertisements had been inserted in English and foreign papers, without result, and the police at Biarritz had come to the conclusion that Mr. Reiche had died on April 10.

Leave was given to presume the death as from April 10.

RICH MERCHANT DISAPPEARS.

Probate Court Grant Leave to Presume His Death as
Having Taken Place at Biarritz.

Tere was a further development yesterday in regard to the remarkable disappearance in April last of Mr. Adolph Reiche, wool-top and oil merchat, of Bradford.

At the time the affair caused a great sensation in

the wool capital of Yorkshire.

He disappeared whilst on a trip to the Continent, and yesterday in the Probate Court leave was granted to presume his death as having taken place on or since April 10, at Biarritz.


The evidence showed that on the cliffs, where he was walking when last seen, his hat and some of

his property were found.

Mr. Reiche left property to the value of £32,000.

After delivering a telegram at an Eastbourne shop a telegraph messenger walked clean through a plate-glass window, which he mistook for a door. He was badly cut on head and hands.
