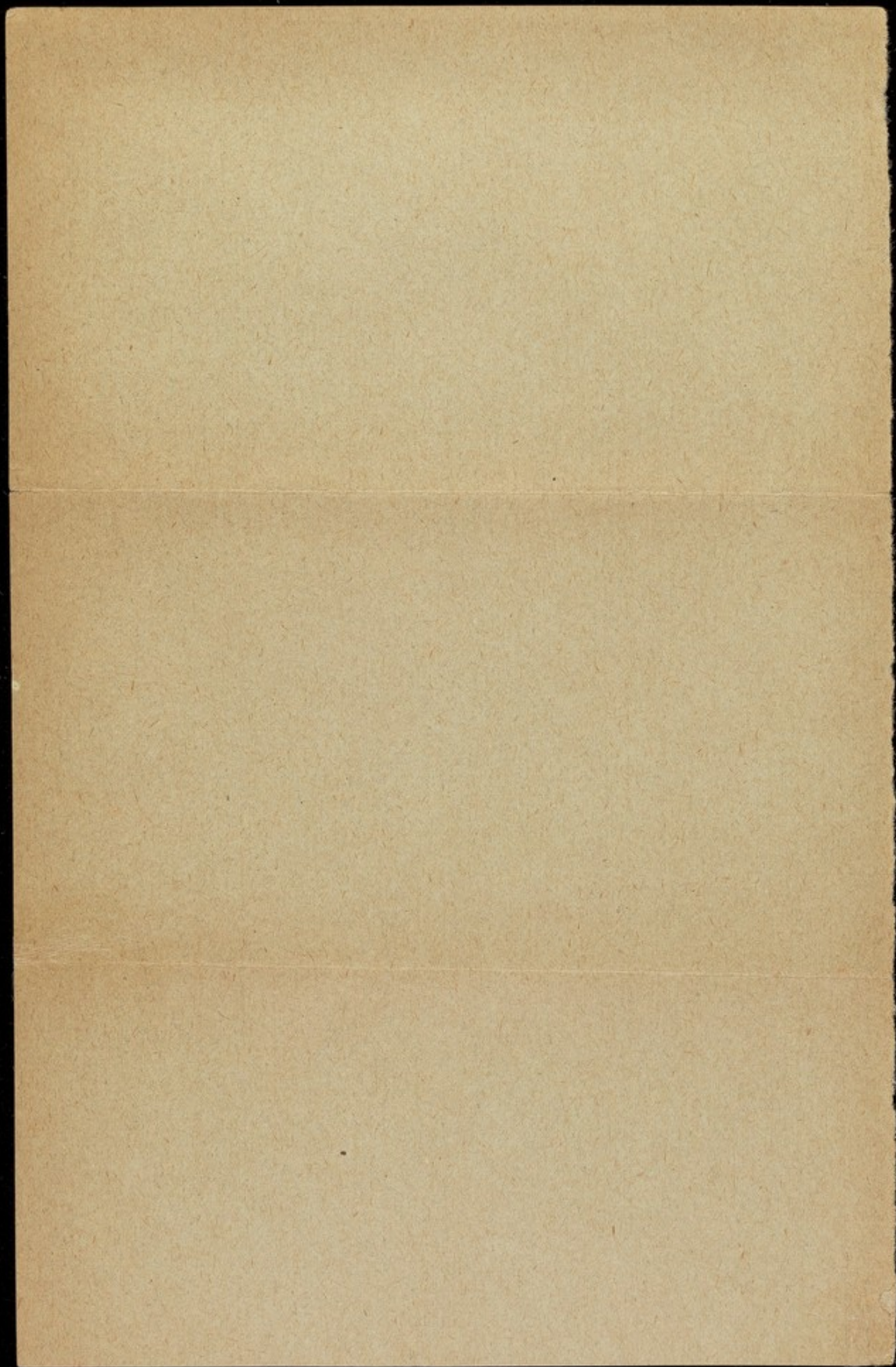

room.



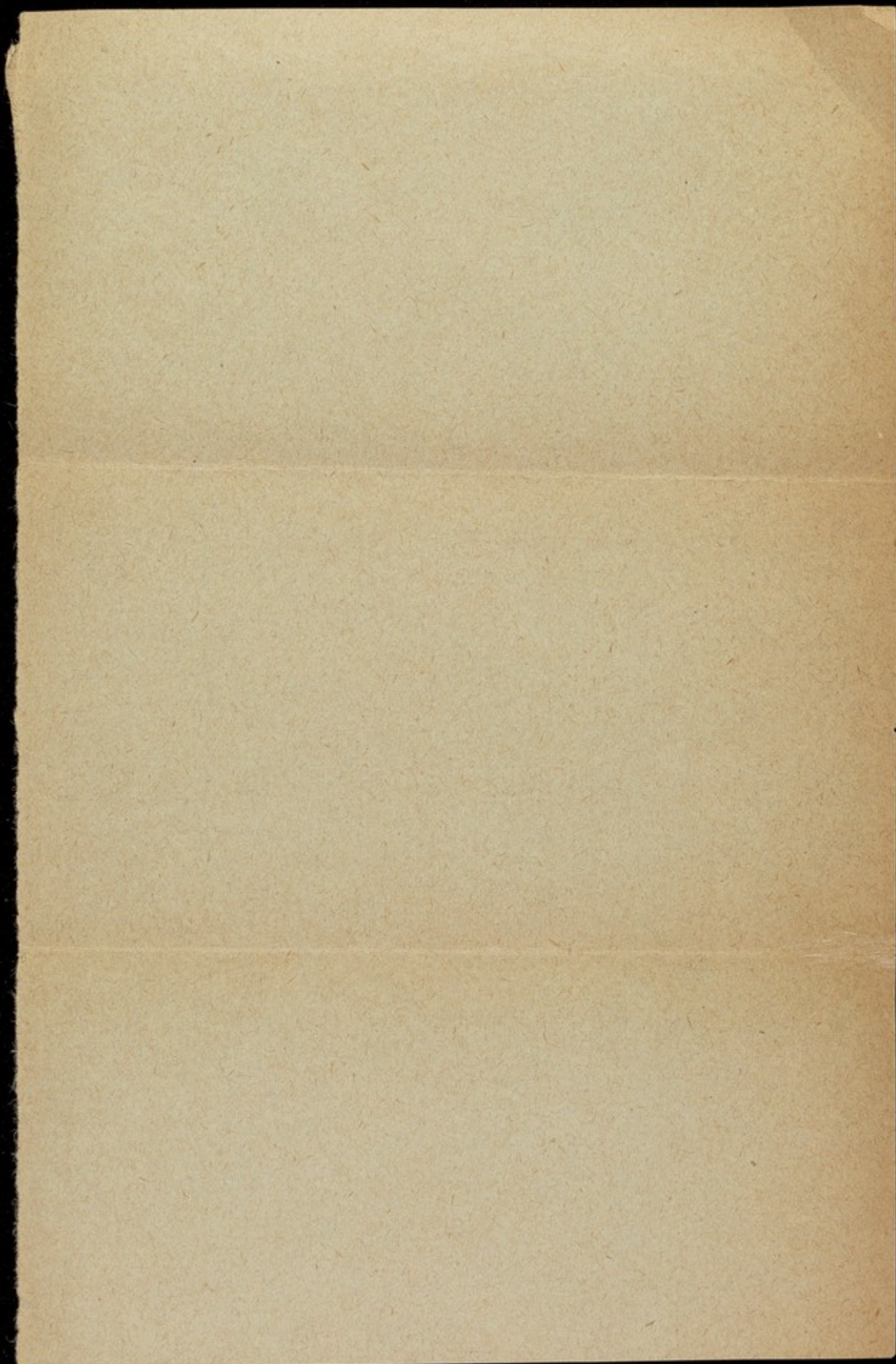
