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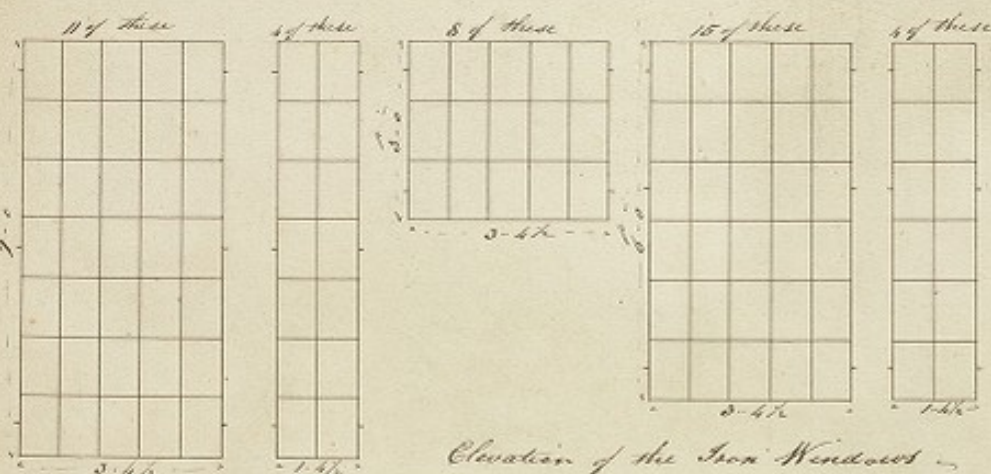
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Section of the

The Superficial Content of the above Sashes is 716 sq. ft. - and will 34 lb. to the foot superficial, each sash to be in one piece - it will be observed that all the Squares are exactly the same size, so that the same Model will do a little altered - The Estimate to include drilling the Holes for fixing them as marked by the above Strokes, in the Sides - The Estimate to include Models both for the Sashes and Beams, the filing and fitting up ready for fixing the whole to be delivered at the Retreat -
