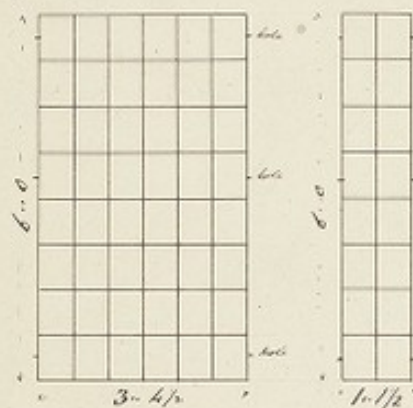

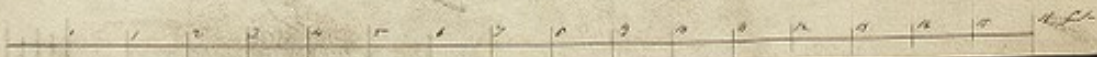

treat near York.

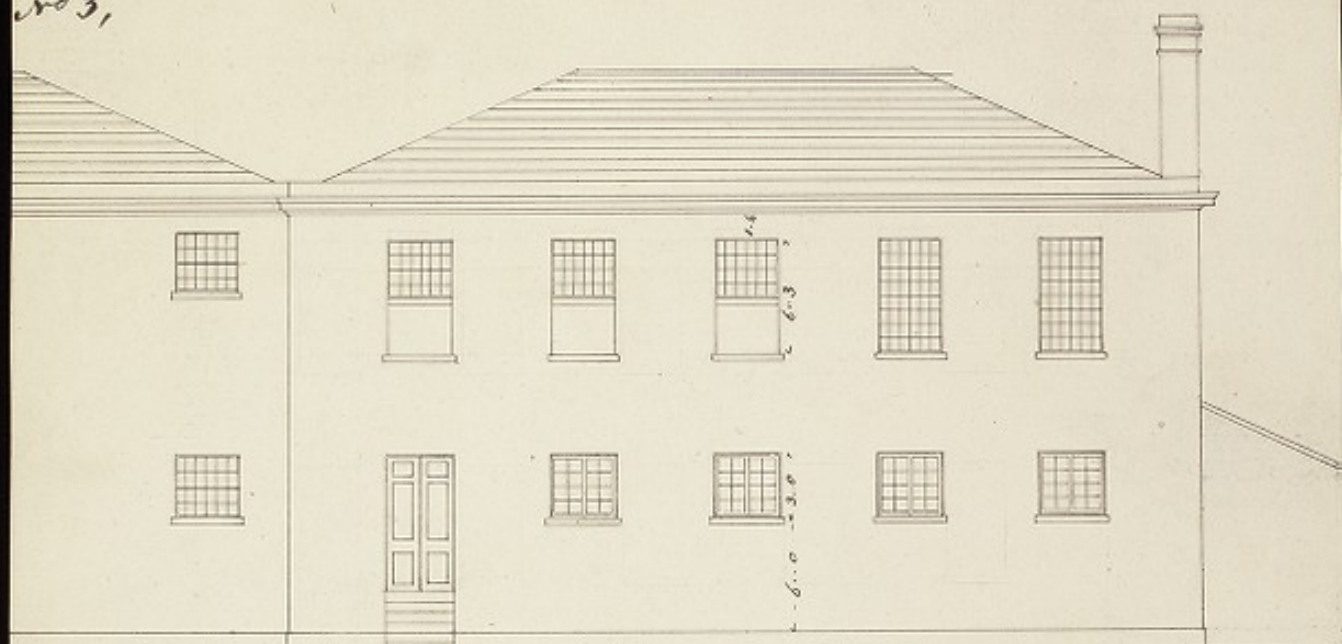

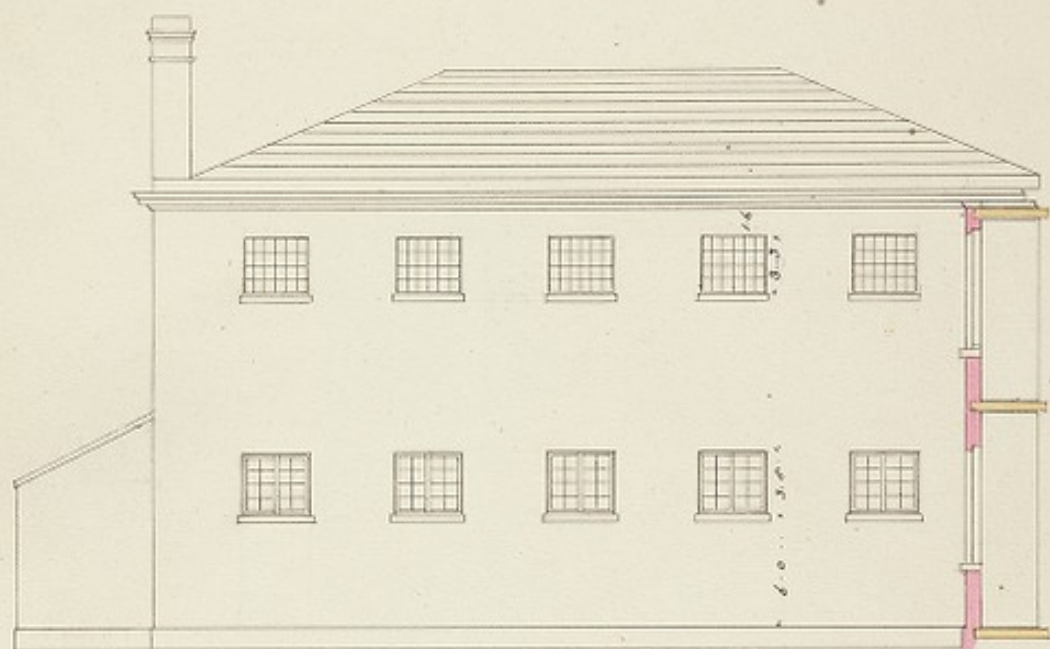




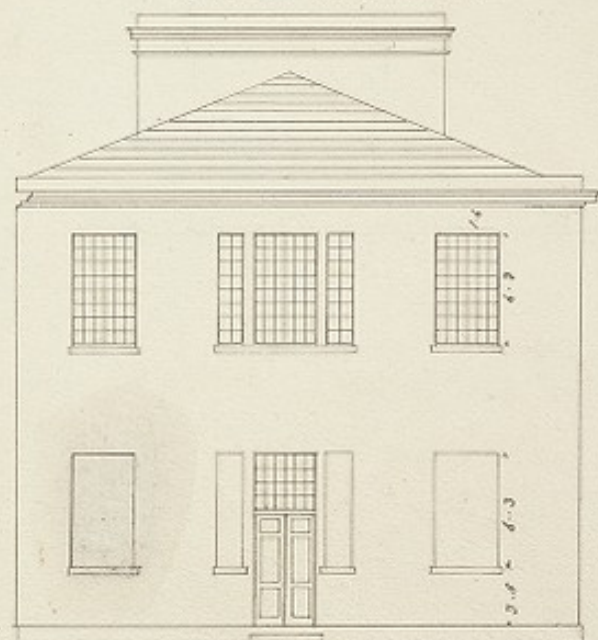

North Elevation



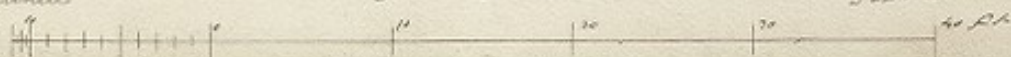
South Elevation

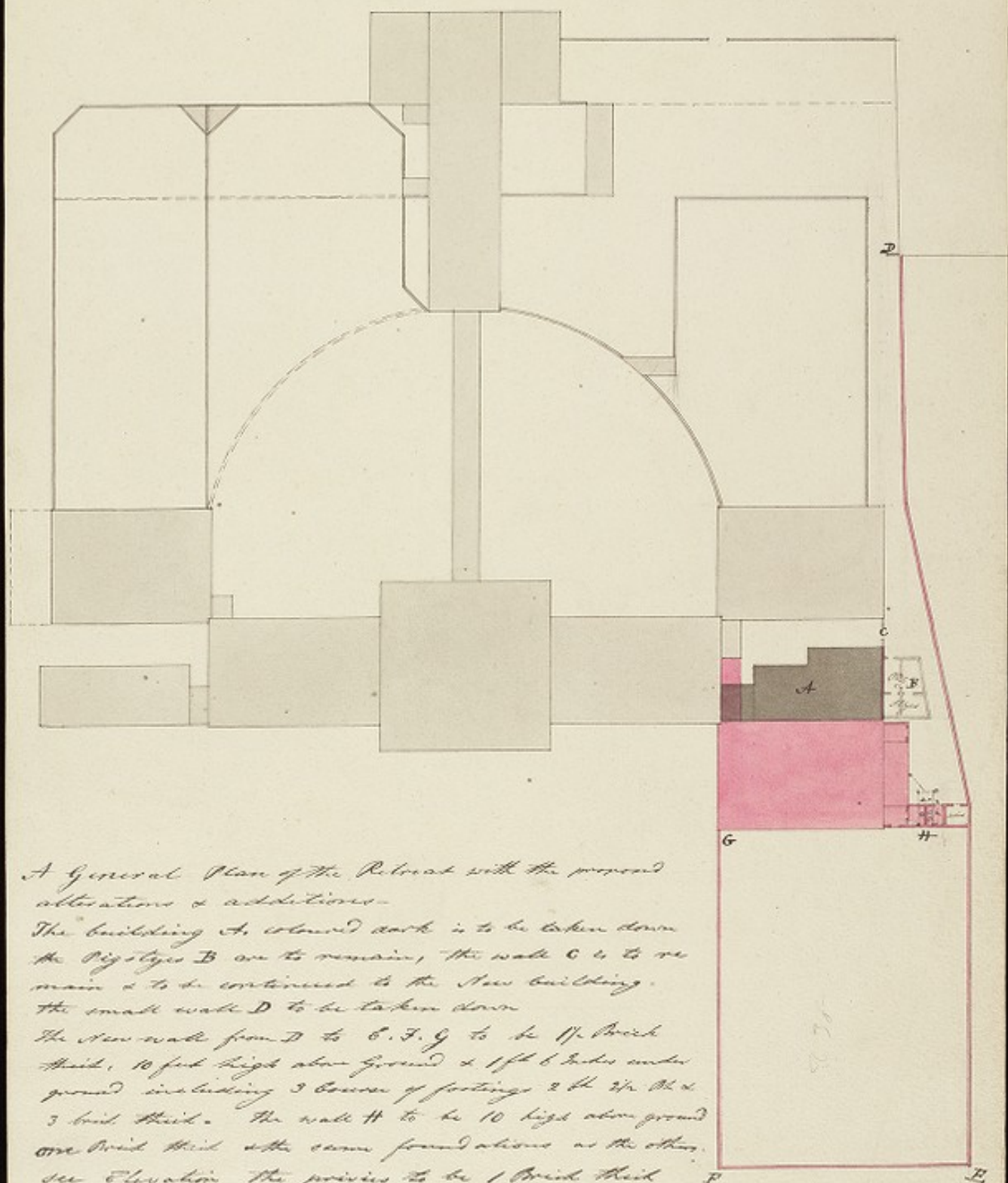

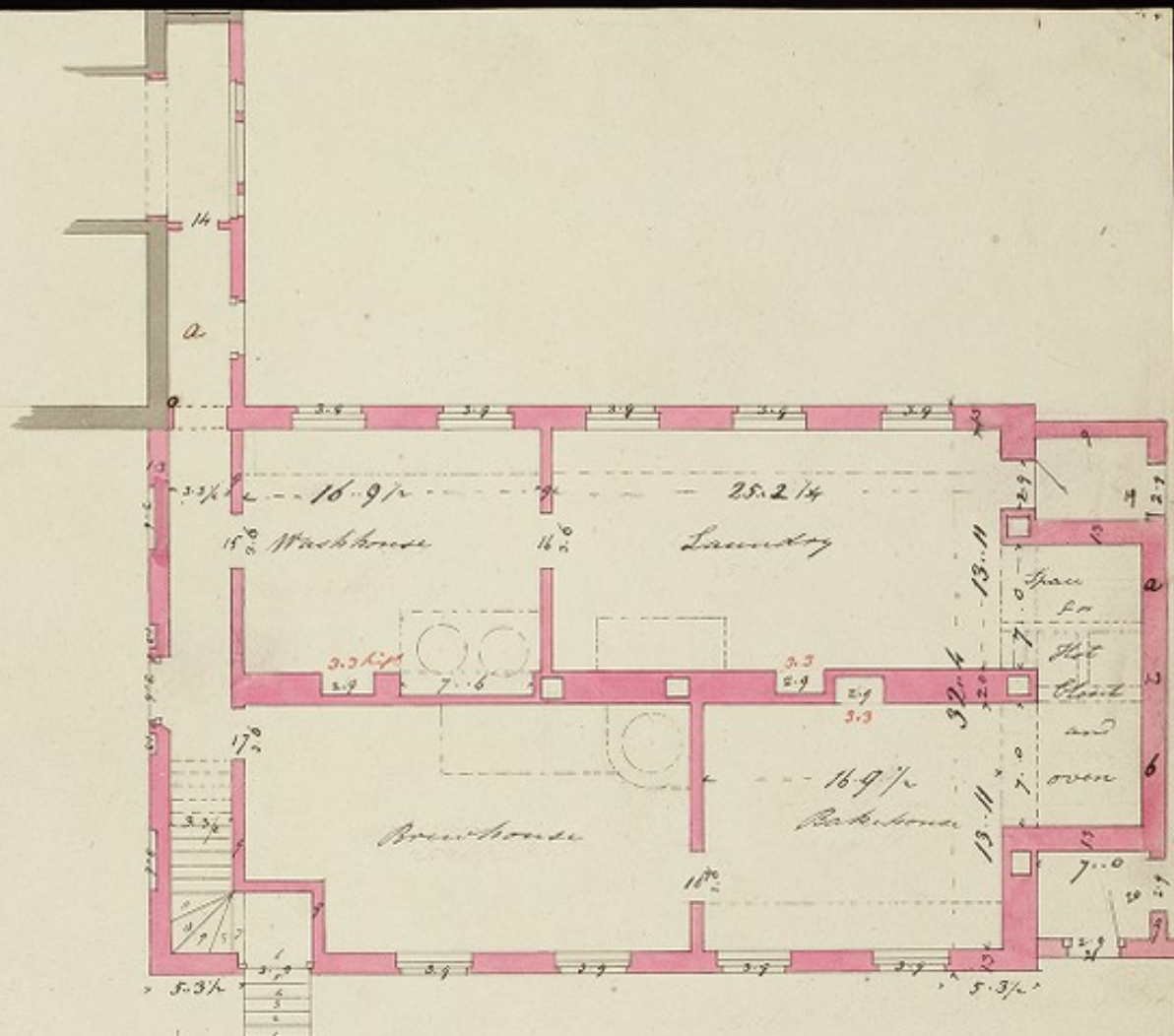
A General Plan of the Retreat with the proposed alterations & additions.

The building A, coloured dark is to be taken down the Pig sty B are to remain, the wall C is to remain & to be continued to the New building. The small wall D to be taken down

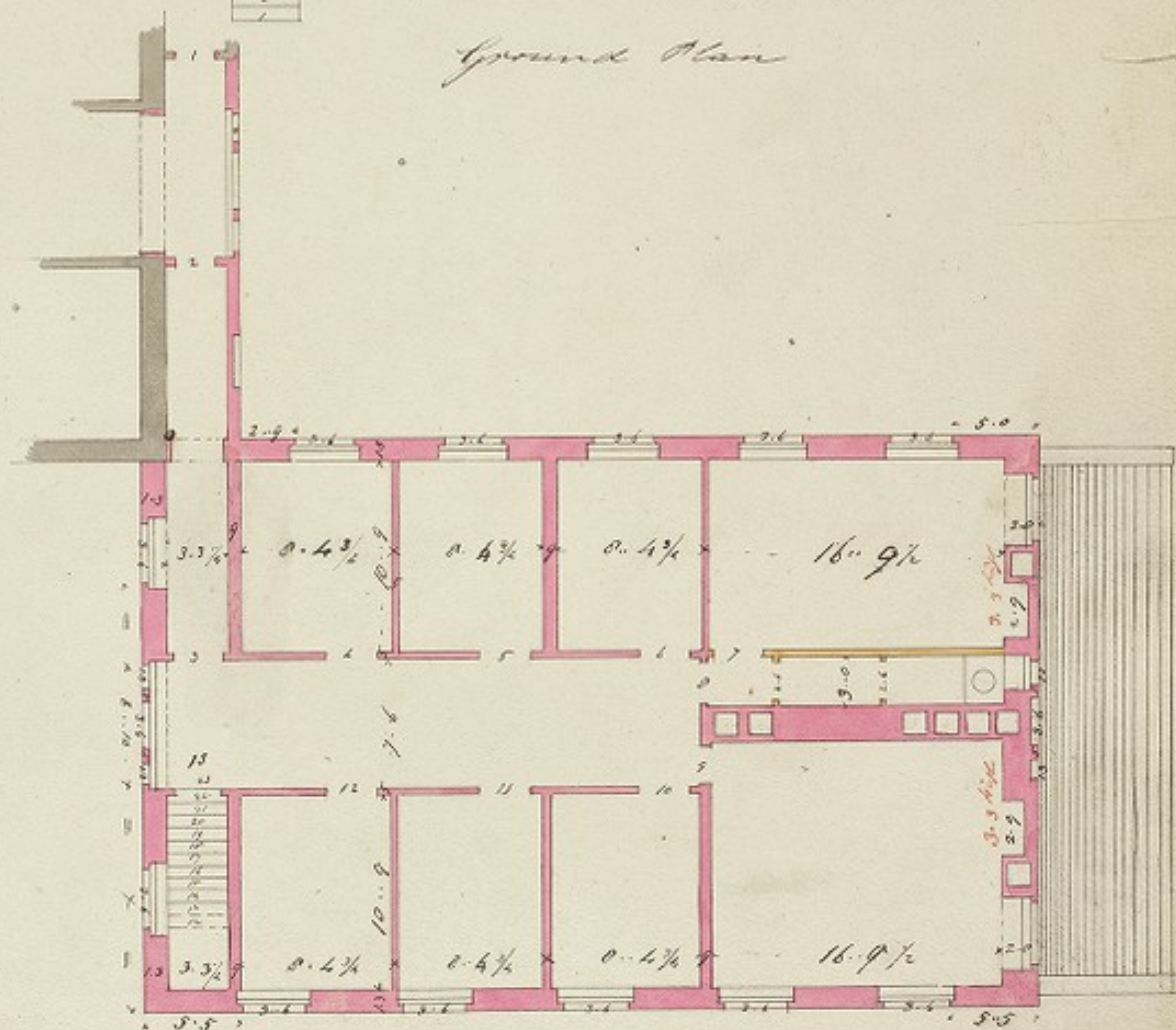
The New wall from D to G. F. G. to be 11. Brick thick, 10 feet high above ground & 1 ft 6 inches under ground including 3 courses of footings 2 ft 2 in thick & 3 brick thick. The wall H to be 10 high above ground one brick thick with the same foundations as the others. See Elevation the privies to be 1 brick thick see section, for the heights &c.

Ground Plan



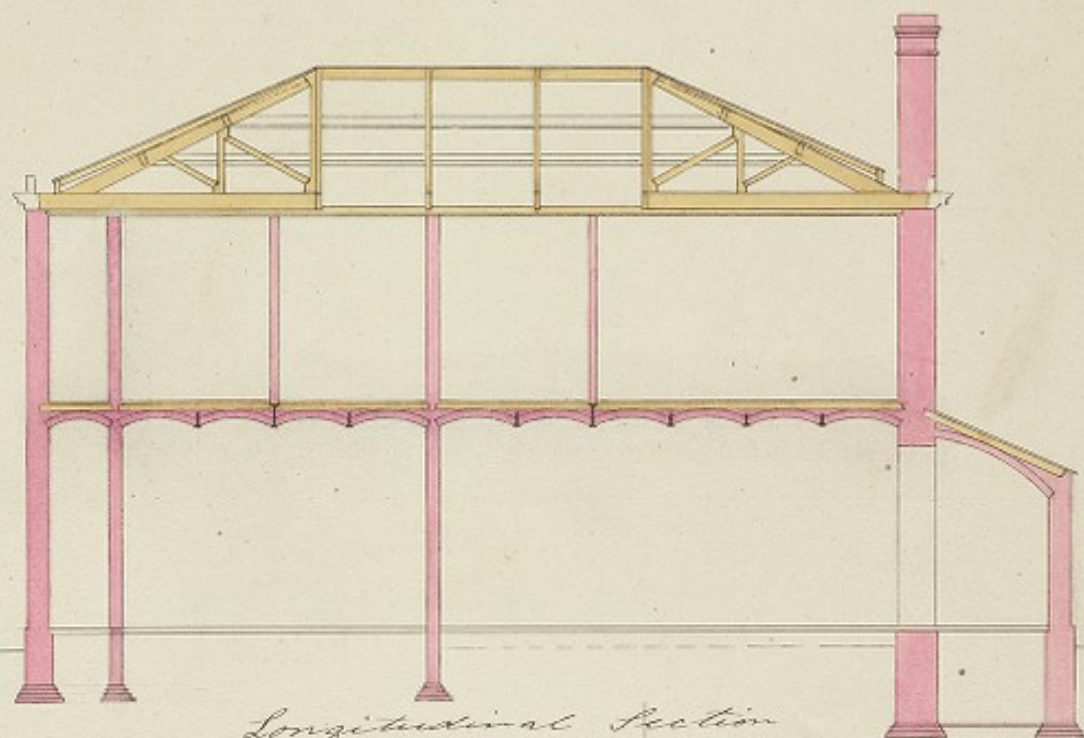
Chamber Plan

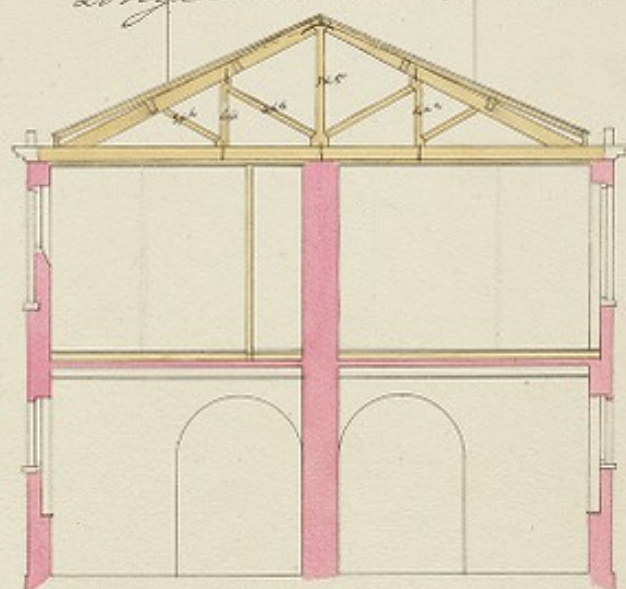




West Elevation

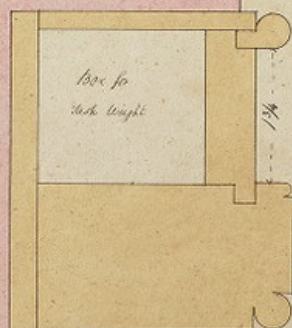


Longitudinal Section
