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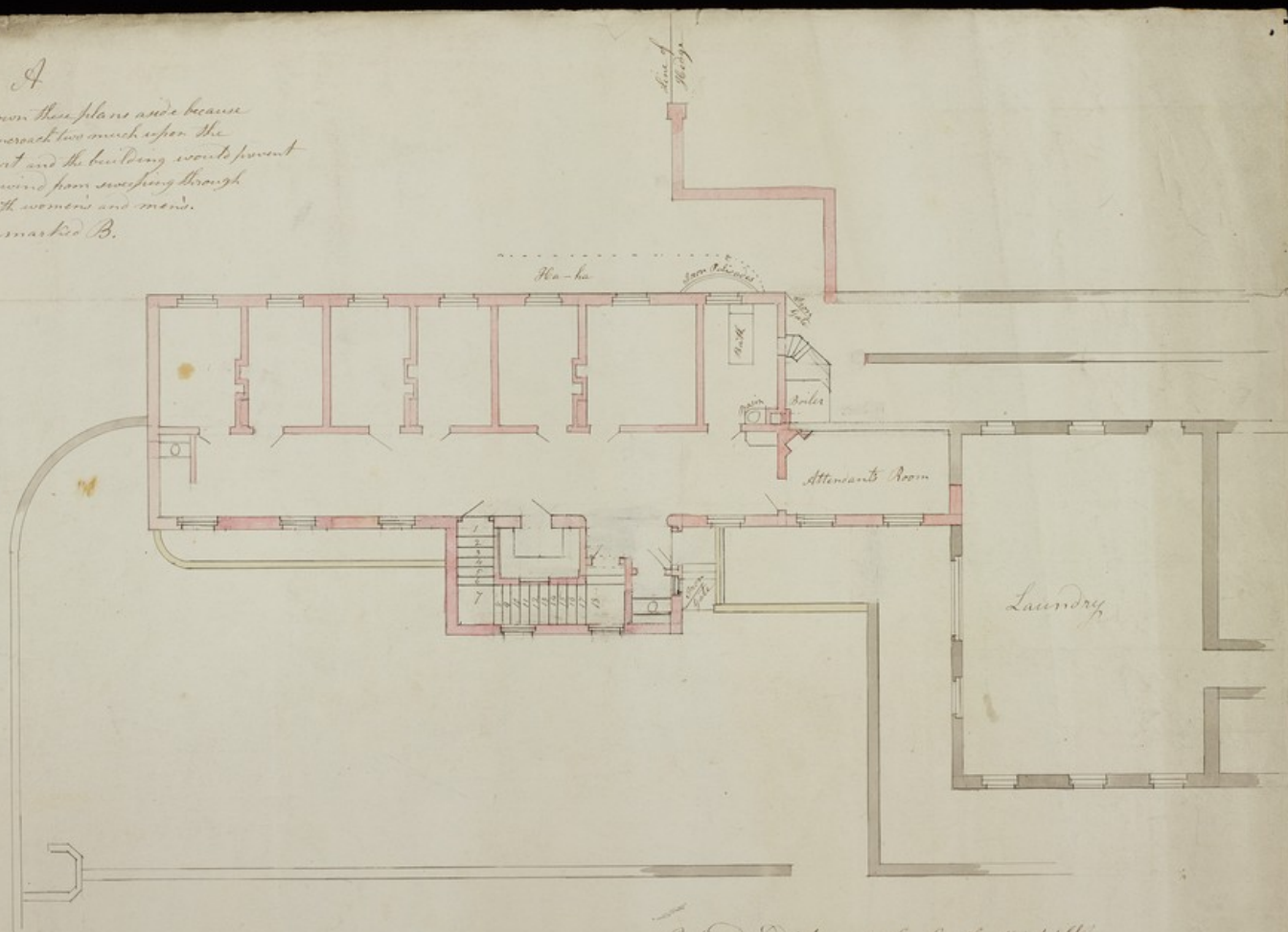

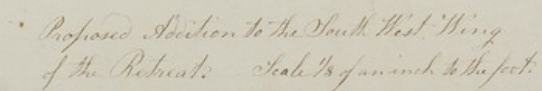
Basement Plan.

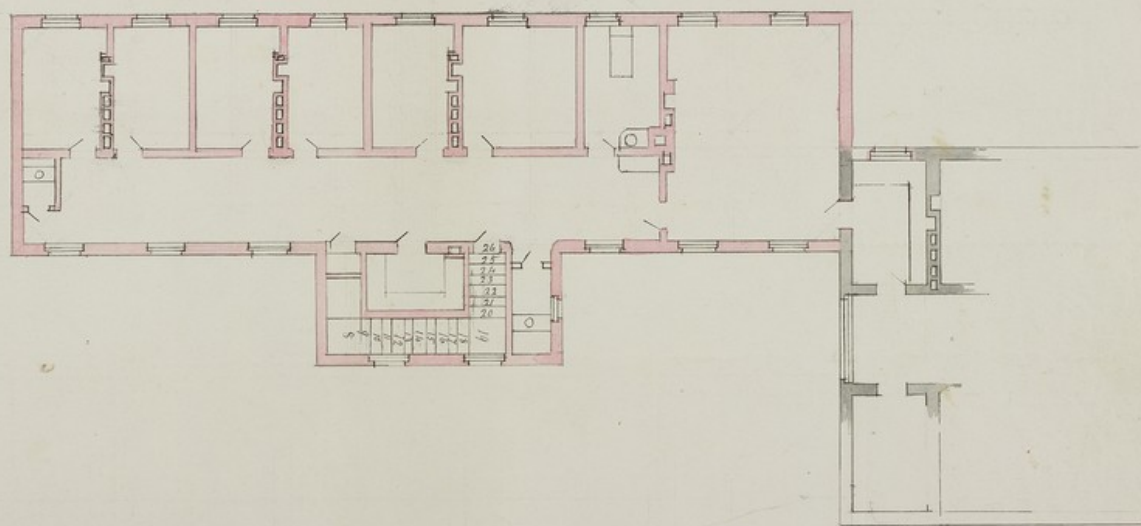

at the Retreat. Scale 1/2 of an inch to the foot

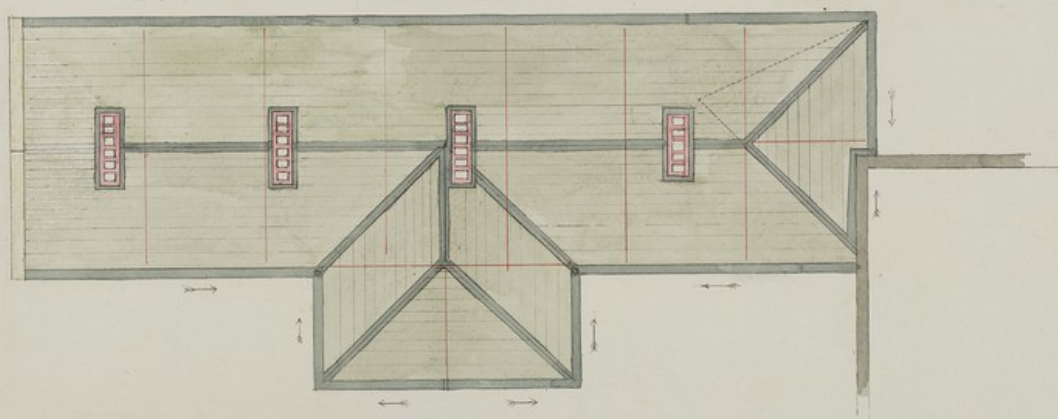
First floor or Chamber Plan

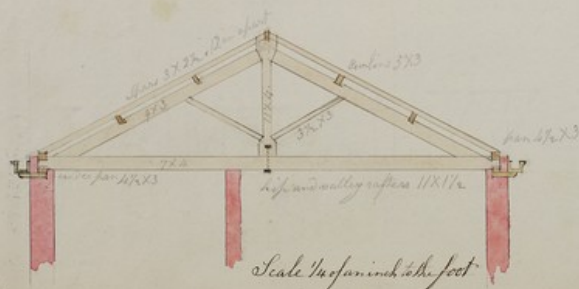


7 Trusses and 2 half trusses

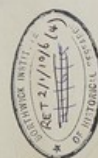
Wood spout or cornice, and lead inside

of the Retreat. Scale 1/2 of an inch to the foot.

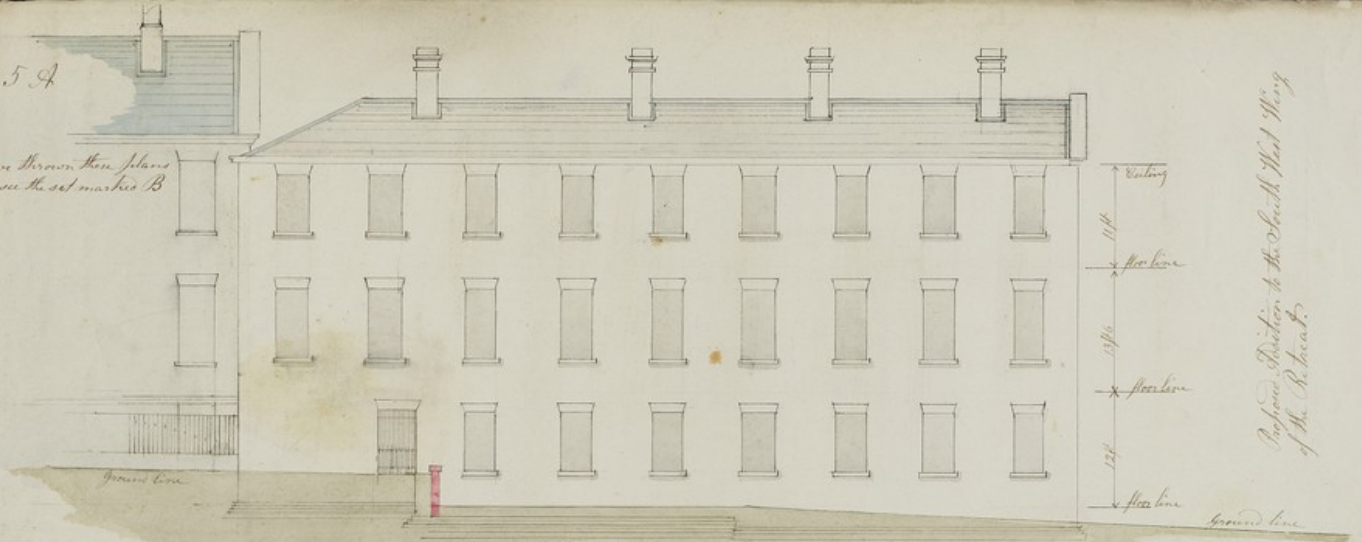

East Elevation

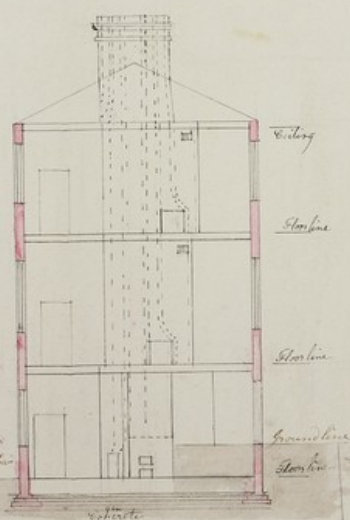

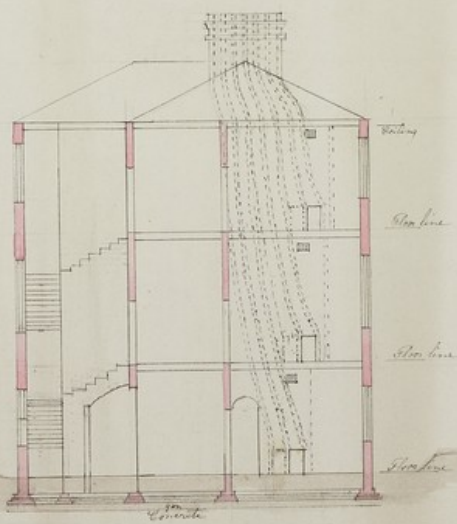

aside as the set marked B.

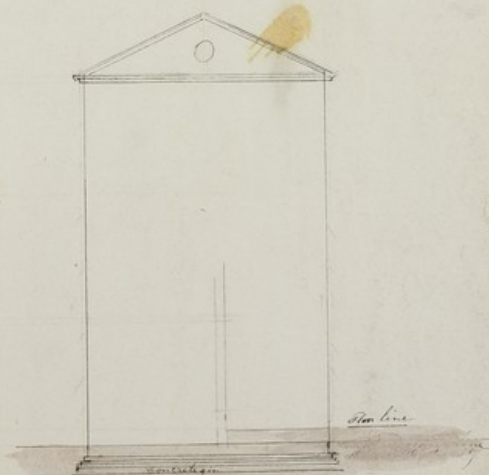


Section through the Dining Room
showing the flues for the same, and
the boiler flue, also a space flue for the roof.
The boiler flue has to be on thin iron plates, and
the roof flue, being, cast in with the brick
work, but not close to it. To have air grates,
to let warm air into the 3 bath rooms.



Section showing the second stack of flues also a
section of the upper part of the stairs. The other two
partitions walls and flues to be the same as this.
