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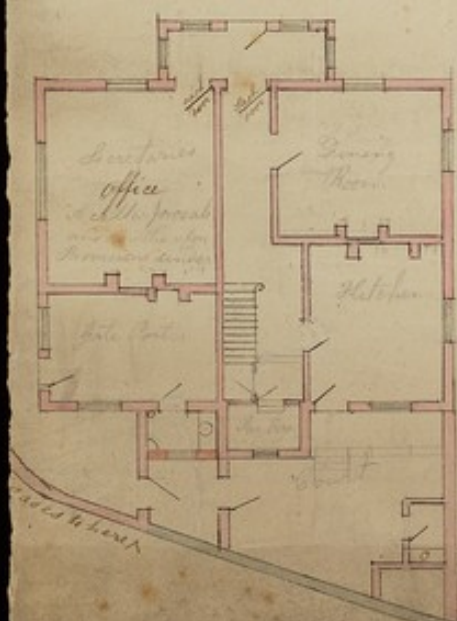

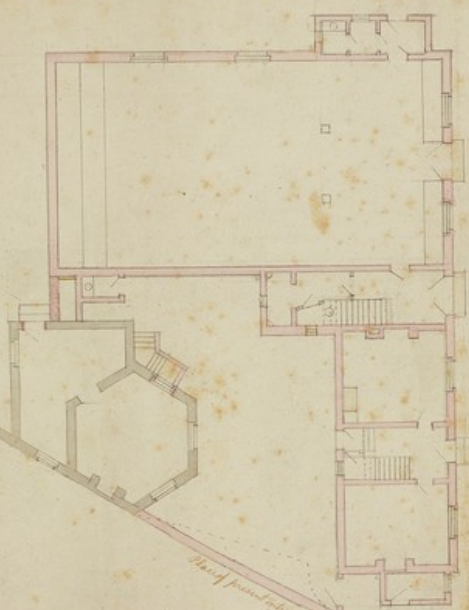
Proposed Additions to the Retreat, being a new Meeting

Gardeners cottage to be the sea room. The present sea room
will be required for Bath room &c when the men patients occupy
the Superintendents house. Scale $\frac{1}{16}$ of an inch to the foot.
The Secretaries house is towards the boundary wall, there
is not sufficient room in the court, it should be 5 ft larger

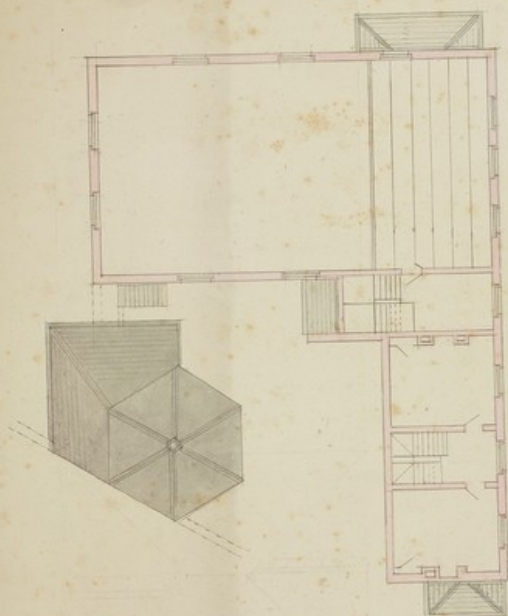

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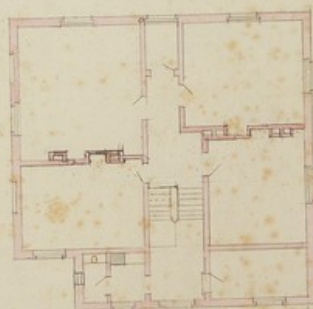

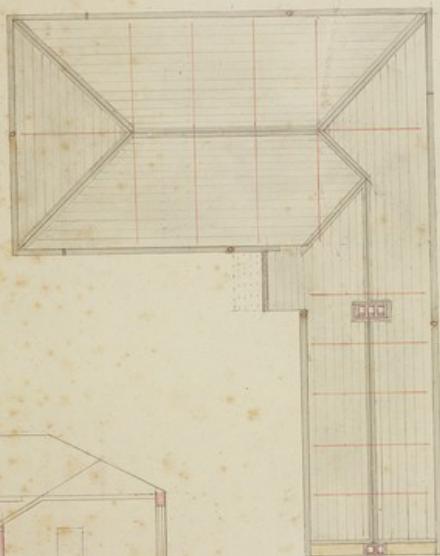

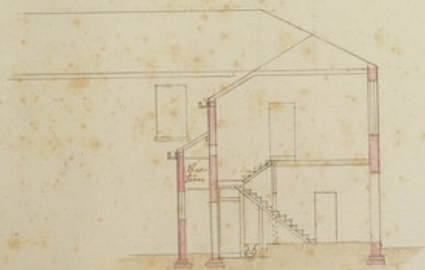

entrance.



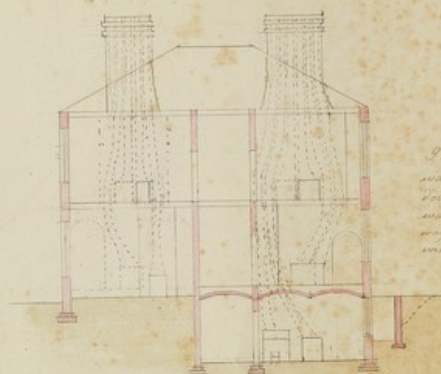
Roof plan of gardeners' house and the building house

Scale 1/4 of an inch to the foot



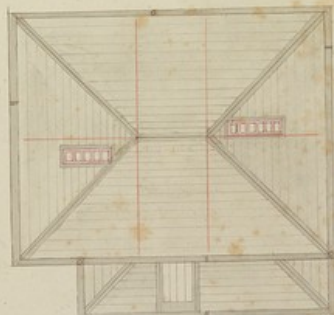
Section showing the stairs &c for

The rain water cistern to be the full
size of the place to supply the sink on
gardeners &c. when the water closet as shown
under the stairs, one a tap to each animal.

I have since thought that if the ground
was deeper down before the wash house were
erected to be better than as much of the
work, as the water line, by ground level, the
wash house and the room above as gardeners
under the ground floor and chamber floor



Roof plan for the secretaries' house

The roof to be 2 hanging and gable
front gables, and 2 half gables.
The back roof to be square only to be
water to a lead pipe.
The water from the flues to go
down as indicated, the highest part
of the front to be built up to the
level of the roof, and the water to
flow down the outside of the wall as
shown, and as with a cistern to receive
as shown, in the larger and smaller
plans. The water to flow into the
cistern, and the water to be large, as it
can be, if it is not yet to allow water
to flow into the roof. The water to be
run to well supply a cistern over the
building sink.

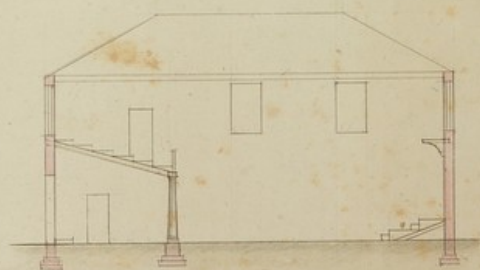
Front Elevation of gardeners house and Meeting House

Back Elevation of Meeting House



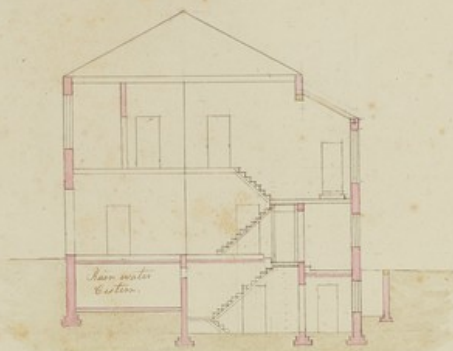
Section of Meeting House

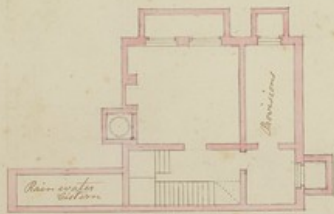
