With reference to your letter on the subject of the periods for which Special Reports and Certificates keep Reception Orders in force, I beg to give the following example shewing the times at which these Reports are to be sent to the Commissioners:-

Reception Order 10 th Feb 1890			
First Report	between	10 Jan and 2 Feb	1891
Second	"	"	10 Jan and 2 Feb 1892
Third	"	"	10 Jan and 2 Feb 1894
Fourth	"	"	10 Jan and 2 Feb 1897
Fifth	"	"	10 Jan and 2 Feb 1902

The Scheduled list of Reports in cases of patients whose Reception Orders are dated on or before the 1st Feb 1890 becomes due between the 1st and 22nd of April of the same years.
