



# BYE-LAWS AND REGULATIONS

RELATING TO THE

# LIBRARY.

- 1. The Reading Room shall be open for the use of Fellows, Members, and Licentiates daily from One o'clock until Six o'clock, except on Sundays and during the month of September.
- 2. Medical Officers of the Army, Navy, and Indian Service who have retired from practice, may be admitted to the privileges of the Reading Room, on making application to the Registrar in writing, accompanied by a recommendation from some Fellow or Member of the College, or from the Head of the Department to which they belong. The application to be renewed after twelve months.
- 3. The Librarian, conjointly with the Registrar, shall be empowered, on the recommendation of a Fellow of the College from personal knowledge, to grant permission to any Medical man to read in the College for a period not exceeding three months; such permission to be reported to the Library Committee at its next meeting.
- 4. The Library Committee shall determine what books are not to be taken out of the Library, either on account of their rarity, value, or for any other reason.
- 5. Fellows and Members of the College shall be privileged to take books out of the College, with the exception hereinbefore mentioned. No book shall be taken out of the College Library by the same Fellow or Member for more than four quarters without special permission from the Library Committee.

- 6. No book shall be supplied from the Library to any Fellow, Member, or Licentiate without an order signed with his name, and such order shall be returned to the holder of the book on its return to the Bedell or other official in attendance.
- 7. All books belonging to the College in the possession of Fellows or Members, shall be returned to the College at least forty-eight hours before each Ordinary Quarterly Meeting.
- 8. Any Fellow or Member having in his possession a book belonging to the College, who shall not return the same at least forty-eight hours before the next Ordinary Quarterly Meeting, or at such other time as the Library Committee shall direct, shall pay a fine of one shilling for each volume not so returned, and an additional shilling per week for each volume so long as it shall be subsequently retained.
- 9. Any book or other property belonging to the College intrusted to a Fellow or Member, which shall not be returned, or which, when returned, shall be found damaged, shall be replaced or paid for by him to the satisfaction of the Treasurer.
- 10. Visitors to the Reading Room are not privileged to search for or examine books in the Library, but can be supplied in the Reading Room with such books as they require from the Library on filling up a form for that purpose.
- 11. The Library Assistant shall be in attendance during the hours that the Library is open, to assist readers in finding the books they require.
