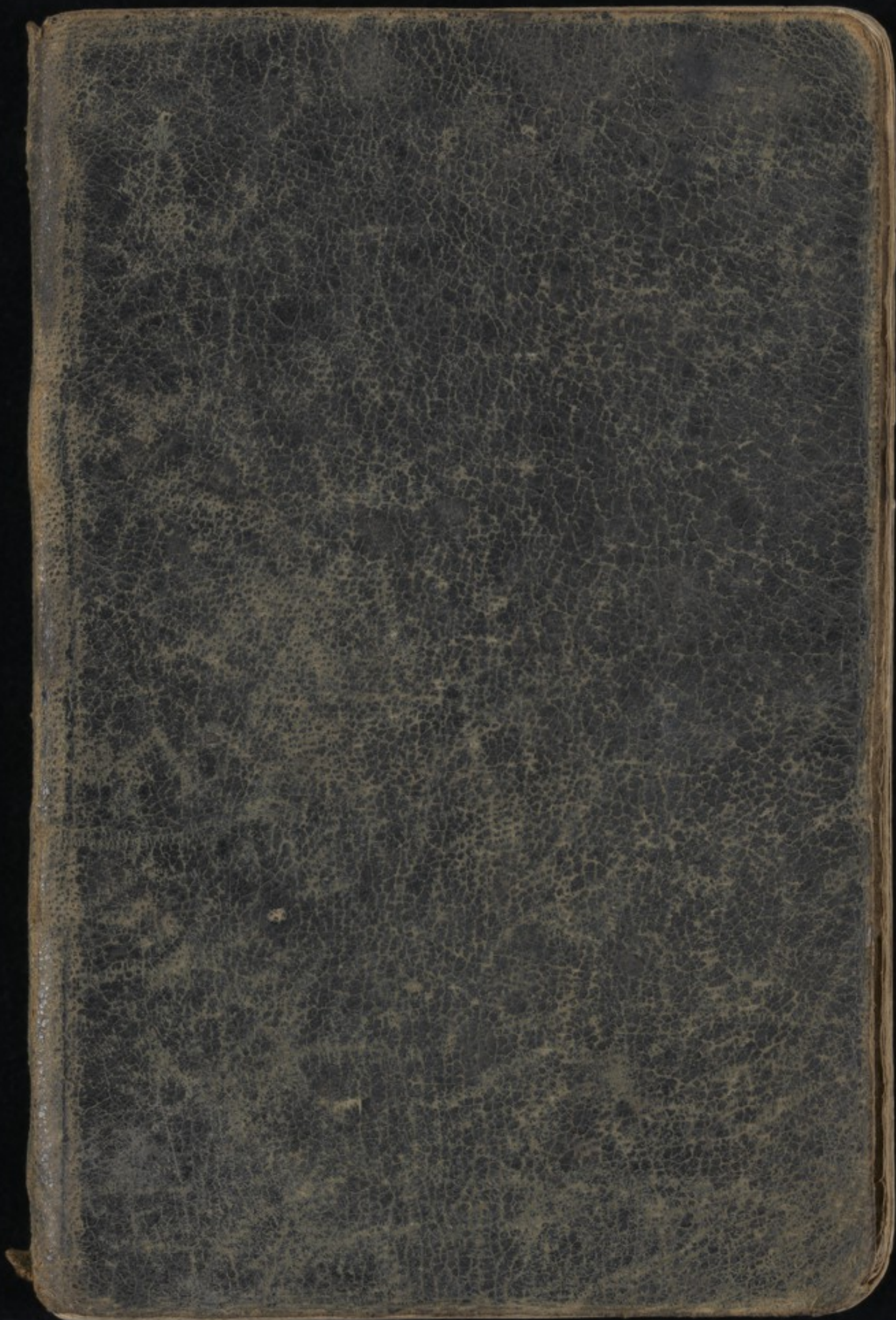

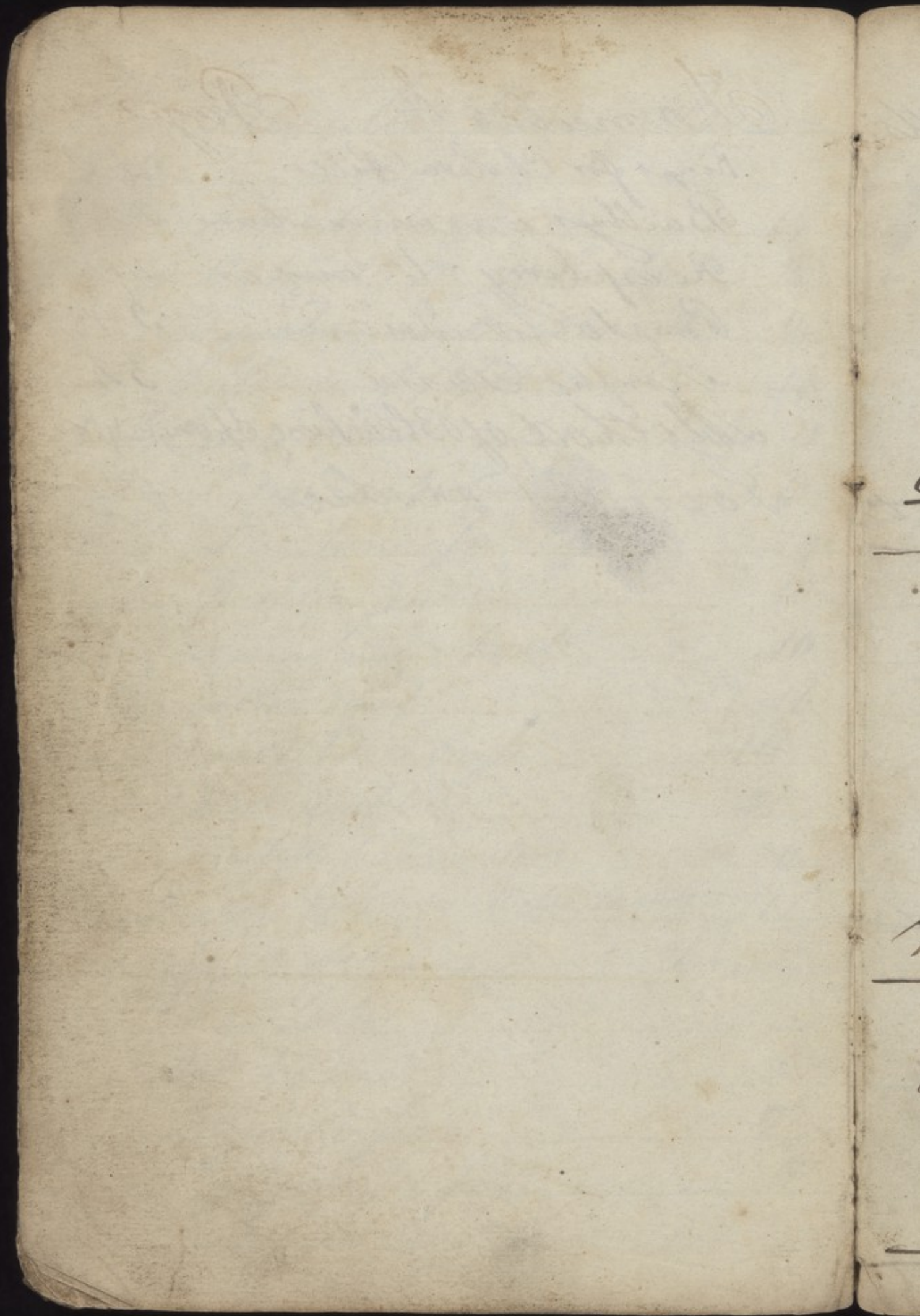

BETTGER'S METHOD OF BLEACHING SPONGE.—The softest and cleanest sponges are selected, washed and squeezed out repeatedly in water. They are plunged in dilute hydrochloric acid (1 part of acid and 6 parts of water) in order to separate the calcareous matters. This immersion is for one hour. They are then carefully washed and plunged into a second bath of dilute hydrochloric acid, prepared as the first, except that there is added 6 per cent. of hyposulphite of soda dissolved in a little water. The sponges are suffered to remain in this bath for 24 hours. A final washing with water removes the chemical substances,—and the sponges acquire by this method a beautiful whiteness.—*Rep. de Pharmacie.*

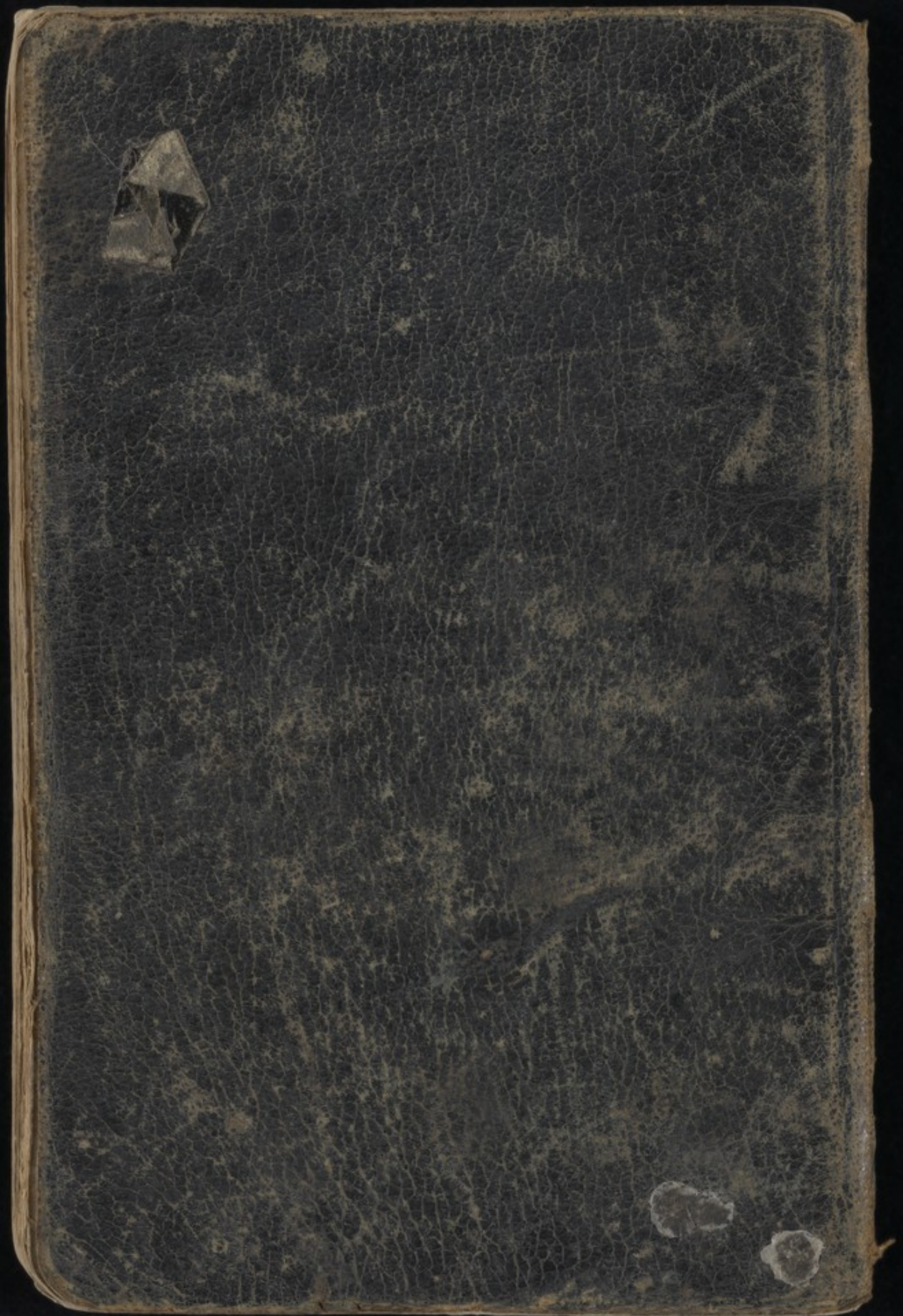

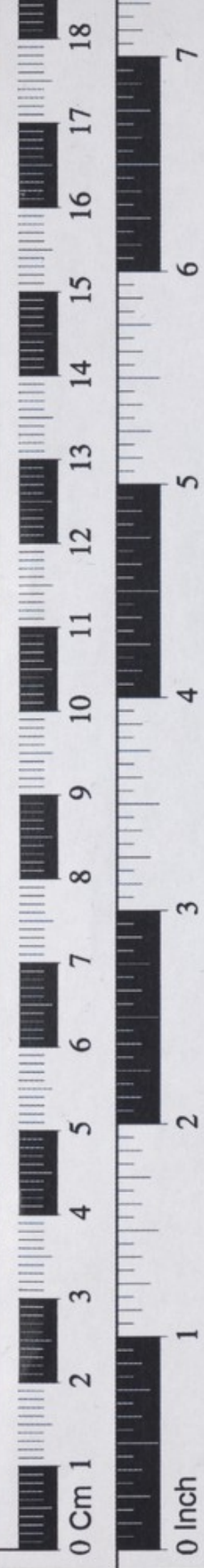
