N.B.—This Certificate is not transferable, and is not valid unless signed by the County Director and the Commandant of the Detachment to which the Member belongs.

It should always be in the personal possession of a member wearing uniform, and must be produced on demand by any competent authority, such as the Military, the County Director, Commandants or the Police.

It must be returned to the Commandant every twelve months for endorsement.

It must be surrendered to the Commandant when the member leaves the Detachment.

1. I declare that I am a British subject, and that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Majesty King George VI., his heirs and successors.
2. I declare my loyalty to the British Red Cross Society and promise obedience to the Commandant and Officers of my detachment. I agree to obey and be bound by all rules and regulations from time to time passed by the Society, and I agree that I am liable to dismissal by my Commandant subject to my right of appeal to the County Director, and if necessary, to the Executive Committee of the Society, who have the right to dispense with my services without reason assigned.
3. I engage to devote sufficient time to rendering myself efficient and I undertake to give one month's notice of my intention to resign.
4. Badges, Brassards, Buttons and other insignia worn on the Society's uniform and issued to members who pay for the privilege of wearing them, will remain the property of the Society. I undertake, therefore, on my ceasing to be a member of the Society by reason of resignation, dismissal or otherwise howsoever, to return to the Society all such Badges, Brassards, Buttons and other insignia.
