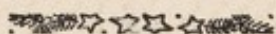

2. 1,000 Lire Notes NOT accepted.
3. No Italian currency accepted above 10 Lire.
4. Win - Forecast, and Tote Double - Tote Double on 3rd and 4th race. HAVE RIGHT CHANGE.
5. Tote closes at "OFF."
6. Winnings must be drawn immediately price is announced and odds will include stakes.
7. Civilian bets NOT accepted.
8. Bet on Mount Numbers NOT names.
9. Bet at the window with your horse or steed's number above it.
10. TOTE DOUBLE. In the event of no winning tickets being sold, the winners will then be those holding a winning "leg" of the double with the steed finishing second in the race, in which no one has purchased a ticket for the winner.
11. In the event of a "Dead Heat" the forecast will be paid on those two steeds dead-heating - there will thus be two forecast prices for that race.
12. Tote opens 1400 Hours.
13. Stable and Saddling Enclosure strictly OUT OF BOUNDS to all ranks other than authorised officials.
