N.B.—This Certificate is not transferable, and is not valid unless signed by the County Director and the Commandant of the Detachment to which the Member belongs.

It must always be in the personal possession of a member wearing uniform, and must be produced on demand by any competent authority, such as the Military, the County Directors, Commandants or the Police.

It must be returned to the Commandant every twelve months for endorsement.

It must be surrendered to the Commandant when the member leaves the Detachment.

1. I declare that I am a British subject, and that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Majesty King George V., his heirs and successors.
2. I declare my loyalty to the British Red Cross Society and promise obedience to the Commandant and Officers of my detachment. I agree to obey and be bound by all rules and regulations from time to time passed by the Society, and I agree that I am liable to dismissal by my Commandant, subject to my right of appeal to the County Director, and if necessary, to the Council of the Society, who have the right to dispense with my services without reason assigned.
3. I engage to devote sufficient time to rendering myself efficient, and I undertake to give one month's notice of my intention to resign.
