# GUARANA

# BACKGROUND

Paullinia cupana – the Guarana vine – is a native of the Amazon region of Brazil. It is a climbing plant that supports itself on the huge trees of the equatorial Rainforest. Within the bright red fruit are two or three seeds, shaped like small chestnuts, surrounded by a white aril. As these seeds emerge from the husks, the white shape with its dark centre has an uncanny resemblance to the human eye, peering down in its hundreds in the steamy green twilight.

*Paullinia cupana* is a member of the family Sapindaceae – it is a soapwood. In all parts of the plant, but particularly in the seed, there are natural oils which combine with the Guaranine and slow its assimilation by the body. Its benefits are felt over a number of hours, thanks to this natural "time-release" mechanism.

# ECOLOGY

The original Guarana culture is centred on the Indian settlement called Maues on the banks of the Sateres river, a tributary of the Amazon. It is here even now that the best Guarana is grown, using methods that have been handed down from generation to generation. Small clearings are made by the Indians, leaving a checkerboard of virgin forest between, to preserve the natural habitat of flora and fauna, and maintain the micro-climate.

As a renewable resource, Guarana is an ideal crop to support local communities. It demands neither huge clearance of trees, nor intensive agri-machinery. It is at home in the Rainforest, and the world's growing interest in it provides an independent economic life for local families and a future for their children.
