As a guideline, we suggest that **BODY WORLDS Vital** is of particular interest to children aged 8 and over, and adults of all ages. This is for guidance only - you know your children best. We advise that all children are accompanied by an adult.

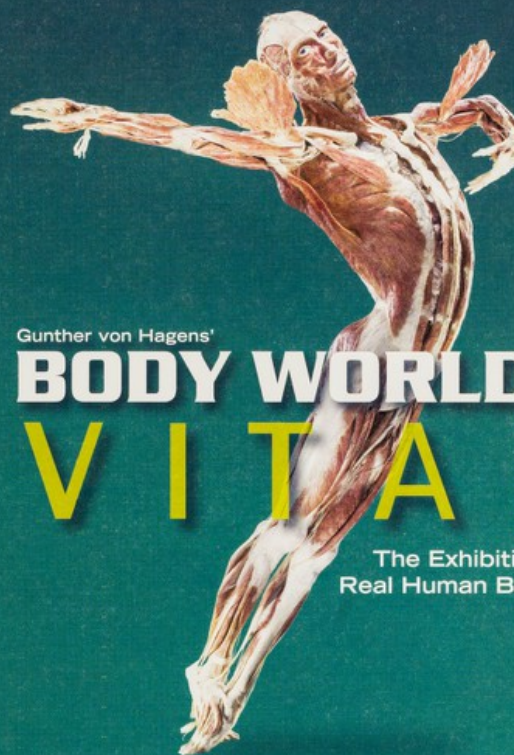
