Ration Books to be Kept

The Welfare Foods Service continues after rationing ends, The present ration book is proof of entitlement to cheap or free milk.

> Those entitled to cheap or free milk and to welfare orange juice, etc. MUST KEEP THEIR RATION BOOKS.

The ration book will still have to be produced for change of address, change of milk retailer or change to National Dried Milk.

After rationing ends expectant mothers will continue to use their grey ration books for vitamin foods.

NEW VITAMIN BOOKS

Coupons for orange juice and cod liver oil in the child's green ration book will be used up by May 15th. A new book will be obtainable at the local food office on or after April 20th. The green ration book must be produced when applying.

Children - - - - GREEN ration book R.B.2

Handicapped Children - - BUFF ration book R.B.1
