DEAR READER,

Two motives induce us to give this brief sketch of our lives and adventures; the principal one being that we find it very difficult to give answers to the number of questions that are put to us by the great quantity of people who throng to see us.

Allow me to inform you, that we are Natives of Ireland, Queen's County, 47 miles from the City of Dublin; we are born of respectable parents, hard-working Farmers, and our father stood 6 feet and weighed 27 stone; and our Mother is 45 years of age, stands 5 feet 2 inches in height, and measures round her arm 26 inches, across her shoulders 3 feet, round her waist 5 feet 6 inches, and weighs
