Felicie was born at the small provincial seaport La Ciotat, in Provence, between Nice and Marseilles. Her parents, who accompany her, are of the ordinary stature. The Father was 58 and the Mother 36 years of age when Felicie was born, they had previously had four children, two boys and two girls, who are now living and do not differ in any essential particular from other people.

At the time of her birth, the Princesse Felicie measured but **TWELVE INCHES**, her height now, is about Nineteen inches.

Another extraordinary fact in relation to this Little Lady is, that she was born with teeth. An instance of a similar freak of nature is that recorded of Louis the XIV., whose dentition was also developed before birth. The Princesse Felicie has been pronounced by the French Press the most amiable and delightful little curiosity ever presented. Her reception at the Tuileries, Paris, was a great event, the Emperor and Empress, and the Prince Imperial testifying their approbation in the most cordial manner.

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
