Aged 27 Years :

He is 34 inches high, straight, very well proportioned, and cloathed in the proper Dress of his Contry. He had the honour to be shewed to their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Orange, and their Court, at the Hague, to their great admiration. The like of this Wild Man having never been seen in England, is now to be seen at the Mitre and Rummer, at Charing Cross, from 10 o'Clock in the Morning to 1 in the Afternoon, and from 2 in the Afternoon to 8 at Night.

He has been shewn twice before the Royal Family and Sir Hans Sloane..
