J. B.—Daniel Lambert was born at Leicester on the 13th March, 1770. At the age of 19 he could lift great weights and carry 5cwt. with ease. When 23 years old he weighed 32 stone. In 1809 he weighed 52 stone 11lb. His measurement round the body was 3 yards 4 inches, and 1 yard 1 inch round the leg. He died on the 21st June, 1809, at the Waggon and Horses Inn, St. Martin's, Stamford. His coffin was built upon two axle-trees and four wheels, and the wall of the room in which he died was taken down to allow of his being carried out.
