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
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# Calcidrine Syrup

Calcidrine quickly relieves the symptoms of cough, for it combines an effective expectorant (calcium iodide) with bronchodilator and sedative agents. Ephedrine makes breathing easier by reducing bronchospasm and by dilating the bronchi; while codeine has a direct antitussive action on the cough centre. The Nembutal (pentobarbitone) content has a synergistic action with both the ephedrine and the codeine, and also has just enough sedative effect to relieve the tension often associated with cough.

These active ingredients are contained in a palatable syrup vehicle which is readily acceptable to the patient, and which itself helps to soothe the throat.

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
