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A valuable addition to Milk Diets

"Allenburys" Dextrin-Maltose

Not only is "Allenburys" Dextrin-Maltose a valuable nutrient, consisting as it does of some of the most easily digested carbohydrates, but also it prevents alimentary disturbances that may arise from milk diets. Its colloidal action helps to keep the curd in fine flocculi in the stomach, and it counteracts the tendency to diarrhoea which lactose sometimes produces.

"Allenburys" Dextrin-Maltose is particularly useful, in conjunction with cow's-milk-and-water mixtures, for the feeding of babies, but is also highly suitable for invalids and persons subject to digestive derangement.

In four forms:

- No. 1—with Sodium Chloride 2%
- No. 2—Salt-free
- No. 3—with Potassium Bicarbonate 3%
- No. 4—with Vitamin D
