#### **PRESENTATION AND BASIC NHS COST**

Choledyl tablets 100 mg (pink) contain choline theophyllinate BP 100 mg, supplied in bottles of 100 and 500, cost 9/4d per 100.

Choledyl tablets 200 mg (yellow) contain choline theophyllinate BP 200 mg, supplied in bottles of 100 and 500, cost 12/- per 100.

Each 5 ml dose of Choledyl Syrup (for paediatric use) contains choline theophyllinate BP 62.5 mg. Choledyl Syrup is supplied in bottles containing 150 ml and 2 litres. Basic NHS cost of 150 ml is 7/11d.
