Choline theophyllinate BP is a water soluble salt of theophylline. Given by mouth it is readily absorbed producing therapeutically effective theophylline blood levels within 30-60 minutes. It is less irritant to the gastric mucosa than aminophylline.

PRESENTATION AND BASIC NHS COST

Choledyl tablets containing choline theophyllinate BP 100 mg (pink), supplied in bottles of 100 and 500, cost 9/4d per 100.

Choledyl tablets containing choline theophyllinate BP 200 mg (yellow), supplied in bottles of 100 and 500, cost 12/- per 100.

Each 5 ml dose of Choledyl Syrup (for paediatric use) contains choline theophyllinate BP 62.5 mg. Choledyl Syrup is supplied in bottles containing 150 ml and 2 litres. Basic NHS cost of 150 ml is 7/11d.
