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THE UPPER POOL

The Upper Pool is the stretch of the Thames which lies between London Bridge on the west and the Tower of London on the east. In the distance the view, engraved about 1845, shows London Bridge with Southwark Iron Bridge visible through its arches and the dome of St. Paul's appearing above it. A number of sailing vessels, including a Dutch "schuyt" are prominent in the left foreground, while in the right foreground are two steamers of the Thames Steam Boat Company.
