#### *PRESENTATION AND BASIC NHS COST*

Fentazin Tablets contain 2, 4, or 8 mg perphenazine BP.

Supplied in containers of 50 and 500 tablets of each strength.

Basic NHS cost of 50 tablets of each strength is 3/4d, 5/10d, and 9/6d respectively.

Fentazin Syrup contains 3 mg perphenazine BP in each 5 ml dose.

Supplied in bottles of 150 ml or 2 litres. Basic NHS cost of a bottle of 150 ml is 4/8d.

Fentazin Injection contains 5 mg perphenazine BP in each ml.

Supplied in ampoules of 1 ml in boxes of 5 and 100 (20 x 5) ampoules. Basic NHS cost of 5 ampoules is 3/6d.
