#### SELECTED BIRDS OF BRITAIN

### **CUCKOO**

Cuculus canorus

The Cuckoo is a regular summer visitor to the whole of Britain arriving in mid-April and departing in early August. It is more likely to be heard than seen, its characteristic "cuckoo" call signalling the arrival of Spring. A useful bird, eating many unwanted larvae and insects that other birds avoid, the Cuckoo is the only British bird that acts as a parasite by laying its eggs in other birds nests. Meadow Pipits, Pied Wagtails, Dunnocks, or Robins may be used as foster parents. The Cuckoo lays one egg in each of 10-13 nests and it may mimic the colouring of the host's eggs. When the fledgeling Cuckoo hatches it pushes the other eggs and young birds out of the nest. The foster parents have to find enough food to satisfy the young Cuckoo which soon fills the whole nest, obliging them to perch on its back to feed it. Male and female are alike measuring 13 inches (33 cm) in length.
