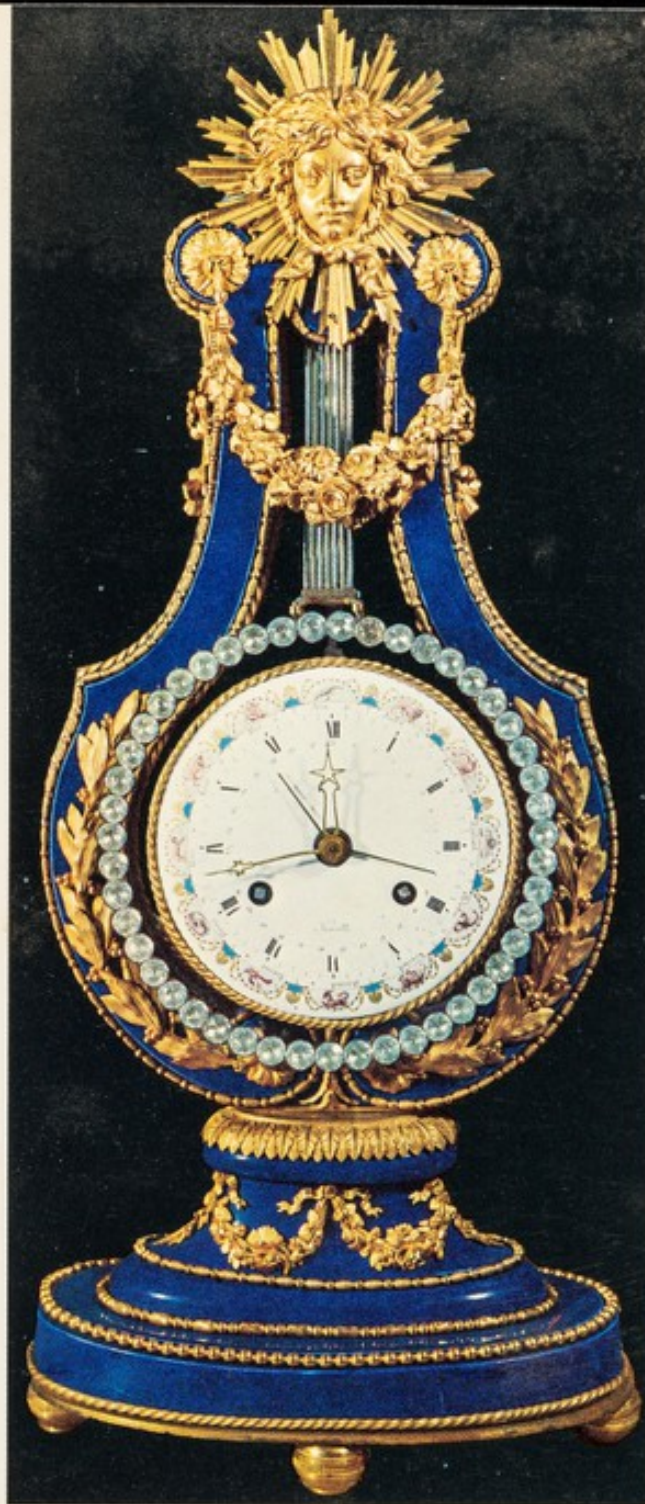

FRENCH LYRE CLOCK C. 1780. The unique feature of this clock is that ordinary spring suspension is discarded. The pendulum - the circlet of paste brilliants surrounding the dial - swings to and fro on a knife edge with the apex resting on a channelled groove as seen on a pair of beam scales. The clock has a porcelain frame and ormolu fitments.

PRESENTATION AND BASIC NHS COST:

Tablets: 2 mg, 4 mg or 8 mg perphenazine BP in containers of 50 and 500. Basic NHS cost of 50 tablets of each strength is 17p, 29p and 48p, respectively.

Syrup: 3 mg perphenazine BP per 5 ml dose in bottles of 150 ml and 2 litres. Basic NHS cost of 150 ml is 23p.

Injection: 5 mg perphenazine BP in each ampoule of 1 ml. Boxes of 5 and 100 ampoules. Basic NHS cost of 5 ampoules is 18p.
