GREENWICH HOSPITAL
The mediaeval palace of Placentia at
Greenwich was demolished in 1662 when
Charles II commissioned the erection of a
palace designed by John Webb on the
site. Mary II converted the palace into a
"maritime Chelsea" for naval pensioners
and disabled men. The building was
completed mainly by Wren and
Vanbrugh. The view, engraved
approximately in 1845, shows the
Hospital seen from the Isle of Dogs, with
the Observatory crowning the Park
behind it. Among the steamers and
sailing ships in the river is a state barge
or shallop. Queen Anne was the last
royal occupant of the palace.


