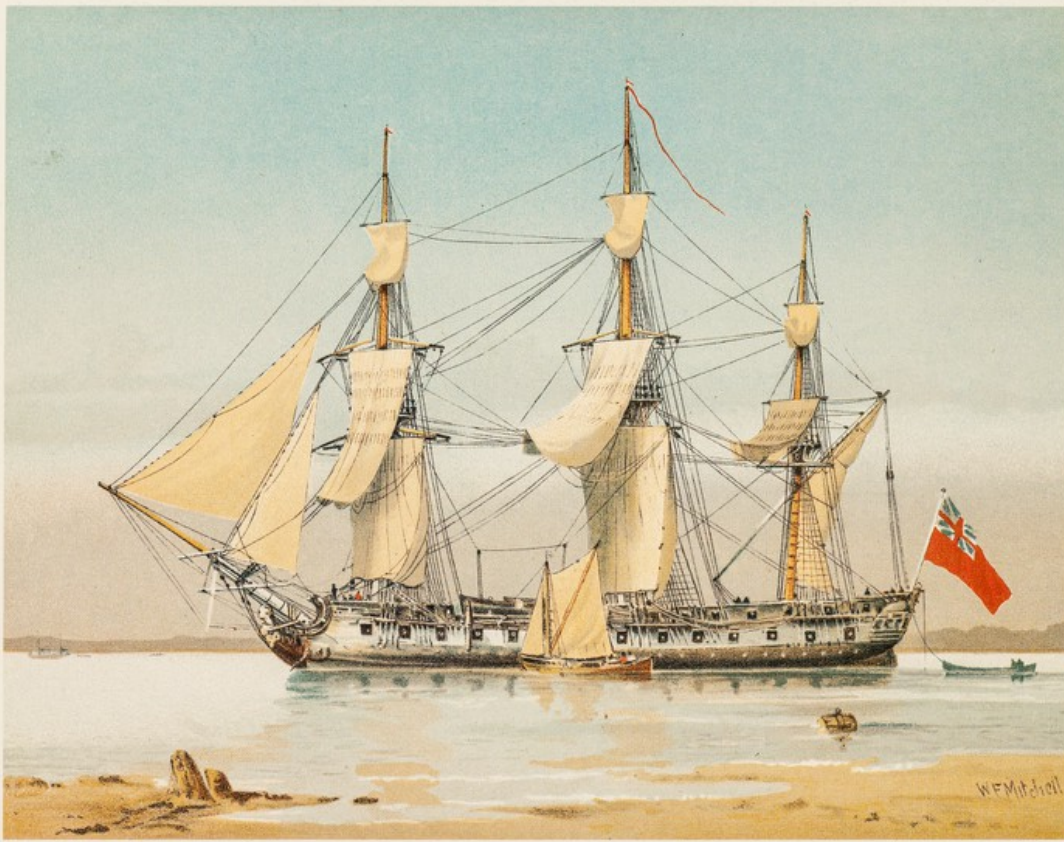

A 5th Rate Frigate circa 1780

The 5th Rates in the Royal Navy in 1780 comprised 16 old 32's and eight new ones with eleven building, all mounting 26-12 pdr and 6-6 pdr guns, two old 36's with 26-12 pdr and 10-6 pdr and two building, one 38 with four building mounting 28-18 pdr and 10-9 pdr guns and nine old 44's armed with 20-18 pdr, 22-12 pdr and 2-6 pdr - a total of 36 with 17 under construction.

Tonnage varied from 660 for the 32's to 940 for the 38's while the old 44's averaged 880 tons.
