Basic NHS cost of 25 Duolets is 5/8d.

PIRITON SYRUP—for paediatric use

—supplied in bottles of 114 ml (4 fluid ounces) and 2 litres. Each teaspoonful (4 ml) contains 2 mg chlorpheniramine maleate BP. Basic NHS cost of 114 ml is 2/6d.

PIRITON INJECTION—for parenteral therapy

—supplied in boxes of 5 and 100 ampoules of 1 ml each containing 10 mg of chlorpheniramine maleate BP.

Basic NHS cost of 5 ampoules is 4/-.
