HAMPTON COURT

The manor of Hampton Court belonged to the Order of St. John of Jerusalem until Wolsey, then Archbishop of York, bought it in 1514. On it he built a palace greater in area than Chambord in France, exciting the envy of Henry VIII, to whom Wolsey presented it in a fruitless effort to stave off his own downfall. The view, taken about 1845 from across the river at East Molesey, shows the Tudor buildings dominated by the Chapel in the centre and the Great Gatehouse on the right.
