Twickenham Ait (or Eyot = Island), known to-day as Eel Pie Island, is connected by a bridge with the Middlesex shore of the Thames. Beyond it in this engraving of about 1845 can be seen the parish church of St. Mary Twickenham, designed in 1714 by John James, architect of St. George, Hanover Square, but still retaining its mediaeval tower. The large house on the left is the Eel Pie Hotel, rebuilt in 1830 and once a noted resort of fishermen and pleasure parties.
