WHITE WAGTAIL

Motacilla alba alba

The white wagtail, a passing migrant in Britain, is seen chiefly in the west in spring and summer. During summer its back is grey in contrast to the darker colour of the pied wagtail. On passage it may stay for a few days to investigate sewage farms, streams and rivers for gnats, flies and other insects. May also be seen following the plough, searching for larvae or chasing flies with leaps and flutters. Gives a 'tchizik' call. It breeds over much of Europe, but more rarely in this country. The nest is of moss, hay and other soft materials, built in a convenient hole in a bank or amongst rocks. 4-6 white, grey speckled eggs are laid in May. Both sexes are about 7 inches (18 cm) in length. The female has a duller colour than the male.
