Constable had a lifelong friendship with the Fisher family, in particular with Archdeacon (later Bishop) Fisher's son, John. He first visited Salisbury at their invitation in the autumn of 1811. The beauty of the cathedral and its surroundings impressed him greatly and he made many sketches of the cathedral precincts, of which this one is an example. He also produced several finished paintings, which proved very popular in London on his return.

Triptafen-DA Suspension contains 37.5 mg amitriptyline embonate (equivalent to 25 mg amitriptyline hydrochloride BP) and 2 mg perphenazine BP in one 10 ml dose and is supplied in bottles of 150 ml and 500 ml.

Basic NHS cost for a bottle of 150ml is 39p (7/9d).
