KING WILLIAM STREET AND ST. MARY WOOLNOth. King William Street was built as the northern approach to Rennie's London Bridge, and was completed in 1835, linking the bridge with the Mansion House and the Bank. The Monument appears in the distance. The church of St. Mary Woolnoth, designed by Nicholas Hawksmoor, appears on the left, its large bracket clock extending over Lombard Street. A large brewer's dray turns into Lombard Street, partly hidden by a group of people carrying baskets, and a man rides into the City on horseback.
