SELECTED BIRDS OF BRITAIN

HOBBY FALCON

Falco subbuteo

This attractive bird migrates to southern England from Africa in small numbers every spring. Lives and breeds in relatively open country. Its speed and agility in flight enables it to strike down or chase and capture swifts or swallows, but it also feeds on insects which it catches in flight with its foot and transfers to its bill. Calls vary: "Kew-kew-kew-kew" rapidly repeated or a quieter: "Wer-er-wee-wee", and a high pitched, single "Keek". Builds no nest of its own; will sometimes live in an old crow's nest or a squirrel's drey. Lays two or three eggs, closely mottled in red and buff. Plumage of both sexes is identical. Like most birds of prey that hunt by day, the female of the species is the larger, reaching a length of 14 in (36 cm).
