No 29 Rhatany 2 grs Ext & Cocaine $\frac{1}{20}$ gr

No 38 Chlorate Potash 2 grs Borax 1 gr; Cocaine $\frac{1}{20}$ gr

No 43 Menthol $\frac{1}{20}$ gr

No 54 Menthol $\frac{1}{20}$ gr & Eucalyptus Oil 1 mm

No 56 Menthol $\frac{1}{20}$ gr; Eucalypt Oil 1 mm Cocaine $\frac{1}{20}$ gr
