
REAGENT STRIPS

- 1. Place 5 drops of urine on square of special test mat.
- 2. Place Ictotest tablet in middle of moist area.
- 3. Flow 2 drops of water over tablet.
- 4. Observe colour of mat around tablet exactly 30 seconds later.
- Positive Mat around tablet turns bluish-purple within 30 seconds. Amount of bilirubin is roughly proportional to intensity of bluish-purple colour and speed with which it develops.
- **Negative** Mat around tablet remains unchanged at 30 seconds or turns faintly red or orange.
