## Treatment of ASTHMA, PERENNIAL HAY FEVER, etc. with

### A. TEST SETS (BENCARD)

Intradermal testing sets in ampoules in connection with the treatment with "Mixed Inhalants Solution" with intradermal needle are supplied at 2/6 per set (2/- without the needle).

If the test gives a positive reaction it is practically certain that the treatment with injections of "Mixed Inhalants Solution" will give a satisfactory result. If the test gives a negative reaction we welcome enquiries for specific protein test sets.

### B. MIXED INHALANTS SOLUTION (BENCARD) for injection.

**Composition:** The solution supplied contains the common inhalant causes of Asthma—namely feathers, animal hair, dust and orris root, combined with a proportion of peptone so as to associate both specific and non-specific measures. On request the solution can also be supplied without peptone. 10 c.c. of ordinary solution is usually sufficient for the treatment of one patient.

suitably flavoured with aromatics

In the treatment of Asthma it is recommended that one dose be taken nightly, without fail for several months, until the patient has been free from Asthma for three months at least.

**DOSE:**—2 fluid drachms at bedtime.

**Composition:** Each tablet contains Betaine Hydrochloride equivalent to 20 drops of Hydrochloric Acid (Dilute B.P.) Pleasantly flavoured with peppermint which is of additional therapeutic value.

**Indications:** Hypochlorhydria associated with allergic complaints, Gastritis, Pernicious Anaemia, etc.

**DOSAGE:** One tablet to be placed on the tongue and washed down with a wine-glassful of water three times a day immediately before meals.
