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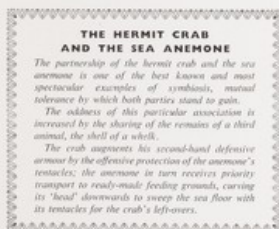
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An unusual degree of tolerance



WITH THE WIDER and more intensive use of aspirin as an analgesic and antirheumatic, more anxiety is being felt at the irritant action of the drug on the stomach.

PAYNOCIL

was developed to reduce irritation due to aspirin in long-term treatment, but has qualities of equal value to patients needing only occasional treatment.

Until now the only way of overcoming 'patient-resistance' to aspirin products has been dispersal or solution in water. Paynocil tablets, however, can be taken 'dry', when they disintegrate pleasantly on the tongue to be swallowed effortlessly without irritation to the throat, oesophagus or stomach.

Most patients who object to aspirin readily tolerate Paynocil. Children of all ages and tastes rarely need coaxing to take *Junior Paynocil*, a new tablet containing 2½ grains of aspirin, a convenient paediatric dose.

PAYNOCIL is a safe and pleasant form of aspirin not only for long-term treatment, but for occasional analgesia. The palatable tablet disintegrates almost instantaneously on the tongue, without water.

PAYNOCIL

Each tablet contains:

Acetylsalicylic acid . . . 10 grains
Aminoacetic acid . . . 5 grains

ADULT DOSAGE

$\frac{1}{2}$ to $1\frac{1}{2}$ tablets placed on the tongue.
Each Paynocil tablet is therapeutically equivalent to two 5-grain tablets of aspirin.

Junior PAYNOCIL

Each tablet contains:

Acetylsalicylic acid . . . $2\frac{1}{2}$ grains
Aminoacetic acid . . . $1\frac{1}{4}$ grains

CHILDREN'S DOSAGE

3 to 6 years, $\frac{1}{2}$ tablet;
6 to 12 years, 1 tablet;
Over 12 years, $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 tablets.

Most children accept Junior Paynocil tablets directly on the tongue. The tablets should not be stirred into water or other liquid before administration.
