

Serial 28 most suited to the nature of the younger woman

It is not known how closely the young woman's soma and psyche are related to her normally high levels of oestrogen, but there is undoubtedly some connection. Consequently, many doctors believe that effective oral contraception should not be at the expense of the young woman's characteristic "oestrogen profile" —not if she is to remain herself. Serial 28 has been designed with this in mind.

Serial 28 ensures that the typical oestrogen-dominant phase of the cycle is retained.

The Serial 28* pack contains 28 tablets, taken as follows:

1 red tablet (containing 0.1 mg. ethinyloestradiol) daily for 16 days, starting on Day 5 of the cycle; followed by 1 white tablet (containing 0.1 mg. ethinyloestradiol + 1 mg. megestrol acetate) daily for 5 days; followed by 1 blue placebo tablet (containing lactose) daily for 7 days. A new course is started the day after taking the last blue tablet.
