Aerosol therapy for generalized airways obstruction

PRESCRIBING INFORMATION

Indications - Chronic airways obstruction due to asthmatic bronchitis, chronic bronchitis or asthma, and all other respiratory conditions where bronchodilation, control of hypersecretion and protection against allergic effects on the respiratory system are advantageous.

Dose

Adults 1-3 inhalations every 4-5 hours as directed by the physician.

Children 1-2 inhalations every 4-5 hours as directed by the physician. For children under 6 years of age, administration should be supervised by a responsible adult. Not more than 12 inhalations in 24 hours. Side Effects - The side effects which may be encountered are those normally associated wiht the use of sympathomimetic and anticholinergic drugs: - dizziness, tachycardia, dry mouth and blurred vision. These side effects do not occur frequently and are seldom severe. In practice they will usually lessen or disappear with continued usage. Occasionally dosage adjustment may be necessary.

Special Precautions - Brontisol should be used with caution in the presence of impaired cardiac function, tuberculosis, diabetes, hyperthyroidism and hypertension.

Pack Information - Brontisol is available in the form of a 15 ml. self-propelled metered dose aerosol complete with an anatomically designed plastic mouthpiece.

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Formula - Brontisol is a combination of deptropine citrate 2 mg/ml. and isoprenaline hydrochloride 3 mg/ml. suspended in an inert propellant. The 15 ml cartridge delivers 300 doses each containing:

Deptropine citrate0.10 mg.Isoprenaline hydrochloride0.15 mg.

Presentation - Each complete unit, contained in one carton, consists of the 300 dose metal container, a plastic mouthpiece and a comprehensive instruction leaflet for patients, including simple breathing exercises.
