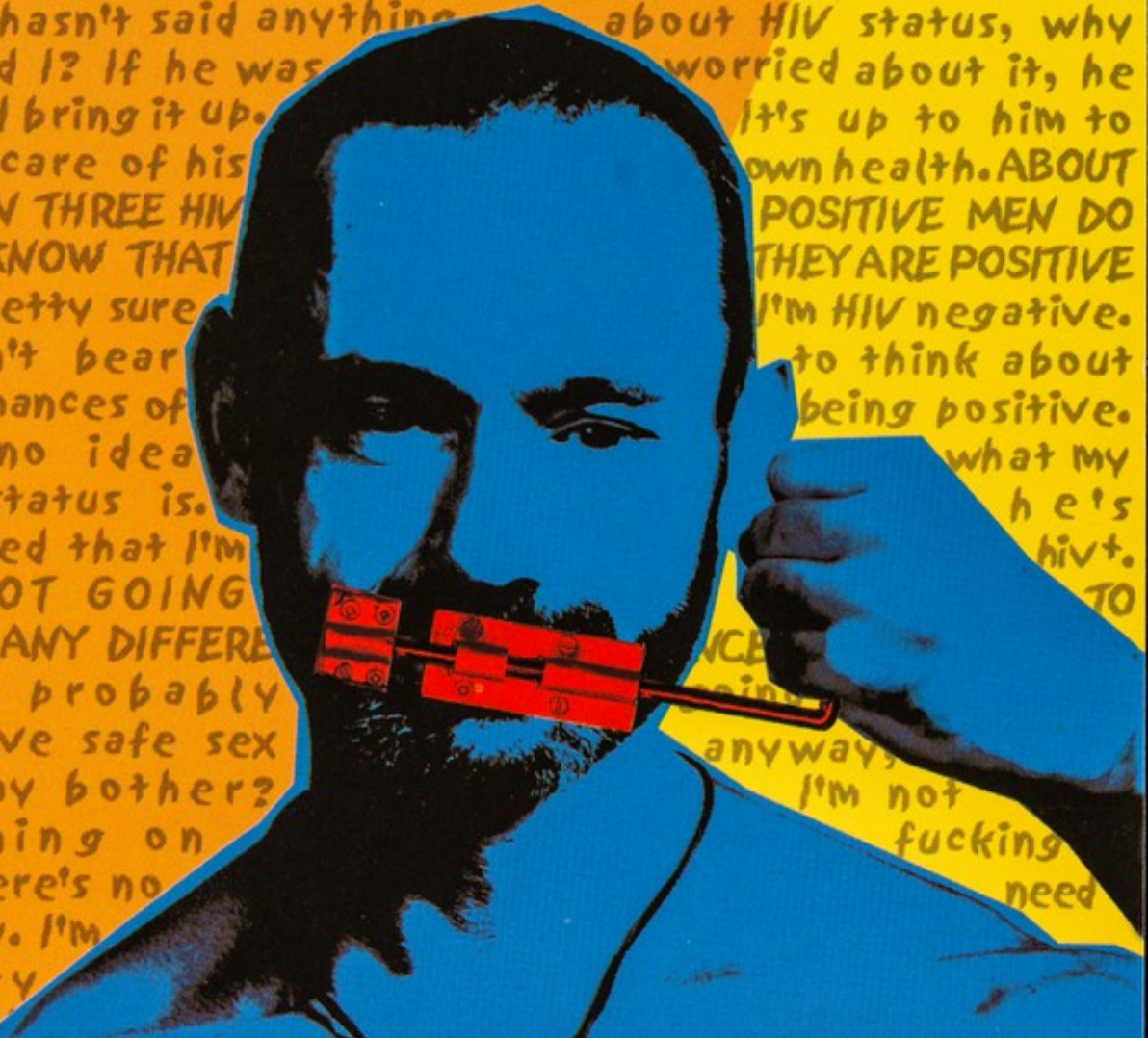
***Now guess why this guy won't
