...which means 5 in 6 haven't

So, often it's just not possible to know if someone you have sex with has the same HIV status as you. Even if you choose to talk about HIV first, only 2 out of 3 men with HIV know they're infected. This figure is for London, the average for cities in England is 1 in 10 gay men with HIV and 9 in 10 without (information from the Public Health Laboratory Service). **We just think you should know the facts.**
